




Humanities and Social Sciences

The Center also prepares for a doctor of pharmacy degree, through its Faculty of Pharmacy.





- Laboratory techniques;
- Radiology techniques.



ASRIC Project

In 2019, these two prestigious institutions entered into a strategic partnership to build the capacity of young Africans and to strengthen research and innovation for Africa's development. Given the comparative advantage and common mandate of ASRIC and UEMF "building Africa's technical skills", the two institutions decided to engage in long-term scientific collaboration and, From there, UEMF offered a scholarship to African doctoral students to undertake study and research work at UEMF.

The 1st and 2nd calls for PhD scholarships for African students were successfully held for the academic years 2019-2020 and 2020-2021, where eligible candidates went through rigorous selection and received the scholarship. Following the success of the 1st and 2nd Call, ASRIC and UEMF hereby launch the 3rd Call for the year 2022.

ASRIC and UEMF are offering 10 scholarship slots for the 2022-2023 academic year to African doctoral students to carry out their doctoral research work at the Euro-Mediterranean University of Fez (UEMF), Morocco. The duration of the study and that of the scholarship is three years.

The scholarship includes; tuition fees of approximately \$9,000 per year, a round-trip ticket from your home country with a maximum contribution of \$1,000 during summer break, and a stipend of \$1,000 per month for 11 months every year.

Signature of an agreement between the UEMF and the Islamic World Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (ICESCO) for the establishment of a "Women in Sciences" chair, in the field of Artificial intelligence. With the objective of strengthening the learning and continuing training of women in digital and attracting doctoral students to carry out research projects in this area, the chair aims to be a starting point for the launch of high-value projects. added to the African-Euro-Mediterranean scale.

Lifelong training

The University has defined its vision of continuing training and development and has been deploying it for 3 years in different forms: short qualifying training courses aimed at developing and strengthening skills, qualifying, certifying and diploma training courses intended for young and old alike for meet their expectations in terms of qualification or career development, tailor-made training within the framework of medium and long-term partnerships, with administrations, communities and industry.

Through its values, the UEMF:


- is open to the world and promotes the values of inclusion, moderation, tolerance, interculturality and sharing;
- is open to all citizens and students and all staff, national and international, without discrimination based on origin, family situation, gender, disability or belief:
- is based on equality of chance and opportunity;
- advocates gender equality and implements a proactive policy to include a maximum number of women as well as people with reduced abilities;
- recognizes and rewards excellence following bottom-up assessment;





- promotes critical thinking, rationality, citizenship values based on civicmindedness, civility, commitment, a sense of duty and common interest as well as respect for others and the environment;
- encourages the qualities of initiative, entrepreneurship, innovation-creation and mastery of languages and cultures;
- has a social responsibility and offers scholarships for tuition, accommodation and meals to the best students from low-income families and from Sub-Saharan Africa.

The University organizes training sessions for citizens looking for work or for adults who wish to retrain in new professions. The continuing education offering is rich and meets the needs of the local and regional environment.



To this end, the UEMF makes its premises, its library, its course modules, and its laboratories as well as its socio-cultural and sporting resources available to this segment of the population, in a spirit of solidarity.

The UEMF thus provides access to educational resources for those not studying at university - for example, computers, library, online courses and access to lectures.

Library

The library is a service intended for students regularly registered at the University, teachers, researchers and UEMF staff. It has multiple documentary resources covering different specialties:

- Science and technology
- Architecture
- Arts and culture





- Social Sciences
- Economy
- Management Science

The maximum number of documents authorized for borrowing is 3 per week. Borrowed documents must be returned on time, without damage. Users must ensure respect for others and promote a situation of calm, tranquility and work in the library. Readers are required to comply with the Library's internal regulations and the instructions provided by staff with good will. Any breach of these rules will be punished. Students who are too noisy will be excluded from the library premises. In the event of late return of a borrowed work, a fine of 20 DHS per day of delay will be requested, under penalty of being deprived of any borrowing ulterior.

Post-Covid educational continuity

When the state of health emergency was declared, the UEMF adapted to this situation by deploying its entire infrastructure (recording studios, 3D platform, virtual reality systems, digital group connection platforms) and its teams to ensure educational continuity remotely. It is also with the support of the European Union and the European Investment Bank, partners of the UEMF, that computers with 4G key were given to scholarship students and young people from disadvantaged backgrounds so that they can follow their course remotely without difficulty.

- The European Union has financed the acquisition of computer and laboratory equipment to the tune of 5.4 million dirhams, with a view to enabling the university to ensure educational continuity for its scholarship students and to manufacture training equipment. medical protection, in these times of Covid-19.(https://ueuromed.org/partenariat-bei-ue-uemf)
- The UEMF also offered 1000 tablets to young people from the Berkane region from modest backgrounds so that they could continue their courses remotely. This donation was made in collaboration with the foundation of Mr. Hicham El Guerrouj, four-time World Champion, Double Gold Medalist at the 2004 Athens Olympic Games and holder of several world records in 1000m, 1500m and 2000m. 
During these days, students are given the opportunity to discover cutting-edge research equipment and to witness scientific manipulations in the laboratories.



Organization of the Royal Air Maroc Hackathon



The "Euromed Sustainable Impact Challenge" Hackathon, organized from January 19 to 21, 2022 by Euromed University of Fez and Royal Air Maroc, closed with the announcement of the winning project "Green Wings".

Green Wings is a mobile application created by a group of 8 students in Business, Artificial Intelligence and Design at UEMF. This application aims to promote RAM's CSR actions and instill them in the habits of employees through three main aspects: carpooling, catering, as well as eco-scoring and eco-ranking.

- Carpooling will help minimize the carbon footprint.
- The catering component will allow employees to confirm or not their presence at the company restaurant the next day, as well as to choose the foods that would make up their menu in order to avoid food waste.
- Eco-scoring is a score calculated on the basis of 3 factors: consumption of water and electricity internally and externally among the various RAM employees, the rate of involvement in carpooling and activities eco-responsible RAM, and finally volunteering. This score will result in an eco-ranking which will elect the best eco-friendly, which will create an atmosphere of competition and play and will allow business to be combined with pleasure.





All these activities will bring significant savings for RAM, savings which will then be used in a rewarding system in favor of the various eco-responsible employees.

This is a platform that brings together groups that work in a Webhelp platform. The latter constitute a virtual football team with the objective of arriving at the top of the ranking at the end of the season. Players/agents must therefore create synergy between them: put the most productive players/agents in the positions that will bring the most points to the team and at the same time increase their ranking in the league. At the end of each season the winning team will be rewarded.

1st edition of the <<MedInnovationTour>> Hackathon



















Indeed, our speaker, Prof. Dr. Ahmed El Hassani, resident member of the Hassan Il Academy of Sciences and Technology, confirms that "Morocco is considered geologically among the countries which relate in a fairly complete manner the geological history of the globe (from the Archean in the Quaternary). As such, it is of major interest to the international scientific community; which means it is regularly visited by a large number of geologists from five continents. In addition to the great diversity of geological terrains, several stratotypes and groups of fossils have been identified in Morocco where they are best represented on a global scale. These riches





remain unknown today by the majority of Moroccans, including managers of natural spaces, and even the non-specialized scientific community. This encourages the conduct of "inventory" type studies which geologists rarely undertake, but which have a fundamental role in raising public awareness of the safeguarding, valorization and rational use of this heritage. »




The target group won the regional and national competition and events and will represent Morocco in the final stages which will take place in the United States.

Prof. ACHACHI's conference on the foundations of Russian geopolitics



The speaker Dr. ACHACHI, once again hosted as part of the Wednesdays of Philosophy; a large-scale conference on Russian geopolitics within the eco-campus of the Euromed University of Fez on May 22, 2024.

The particularity of this meeting is based on its special momentum because it represents the closing of a series of conferences that has crisscrossed the entire academic year and has just been completed by means of a conference that deals with a very formidable topical subject which allowed the audience represented by students, doctoral students and professors, to ask many questions in order to assimilate the current geopolitical situation.

Doctoral thesis defense in Artificial Intelligence by Ms. Yasmine GHAZLANE



This PhD thesis explores anti-drone technology by addressing the gaps in current defense mechanisms against drone proliferation. It proposes a novel anti-drone architecture based on artificial intelligence, blockchain, multi-agent systems, and expert systems. An Al-based electromagnetic neutralization model is developed to counter harmful drones in real-time. Real-time detection and identification models, using advanced algorithms and deep learning techniques, are created to rapidly identify aerial targets. The thesis also focuses on distinguishing drones from other aerial targets, such as birds, by developing a "friend or foe" classification model. It also studies the impact of the depth of the models on their classification performance. The "friend or foe" model is integrated into the overall system with a real-time detection module to improve the efficiency, accuracy, adaptability, and robustness of the anti-drone system in dynamic and complex environments.

Doctoral Thesis Defense in "Additive Manufacturing and Materials Science" by Mr. Patrick MUNYENSANGA



This thesis explores the widespread use of metallic implants in medical and orthopedic surgery, facing limitations such as implant degradation and long-term bonding incompatibilities. To address these, the thesis proposes to improve the interfacial surface of implants, promote faster bone regeneration and better bioactivity, and improve biocorrosion resistance. A lightweight and porous metallic implant coated with bioactive glass was developed to stimulate osteogenic cell proliferation, promote bone ingrowth, and overcome structural bonding incompatibilities. The bioactive glass demonstrates the ability to impregnate antibacterial and therapeutic agents essential for osseointegration with the host organism. The results confirmed the formation of a bone-like bone layer on the implant surface, as well as improved biocorrosion resistance. This surface modification approach shows significant potential to improve the durability of orthopedic implants.

Doctoral thesis defense in Artificial Intelligence by Mr. Abebaw Degu



This thesis explores the use of reinforcement learning (RL) to improve shop floor scheduling in smart manufacturing. Due to the complexity and dynamic nature of modern manufacturing environments, traditional scheduling techniques are not sufficient. The thesis proposes a Deep Reinforcement Learning (DRL) model to minimize production time and a Triple Deep Q Network (TDQN) model for flexible scheduling, taking into account machine failures and other dynamic events. The results show that these approaches improve the efficiency, accuracy, and stability of shop floor scheduling, thereby increasing the competitiveness of manufacturers in smart manufacturing.

Between Cordoba and Marrakech: a barzakh between Ibn Rochd and Averroes





The exchange with the audience opened new philosophical perspectives, consolidating the impact of this enriching meeting.

UEMF hosts international science dissemination project on antimicrobial resistance and the fight against superbugs



The Micromonde project, developed in 17 countries, aims to bring scientific culture and biomedical research closer to students while promoting a vocation for research. The first edition ended on the campus of the Euromed University of Fez (UEMF), with the participation of more than 100 students in pharmacy, biomedical engineering and biotechnology. Supervised by teachers from the UEMF and the University of Valencia, they conducted experiments to discover new bacterial strains that produce antibiotics.

The project uses a project-based learning (PBL) method to encourage critical thinking and problem solving. This program is part of international initiatives, such as the Small World Initiative, born at Yale in 2012, to respond to the need for new antibiotics in the face of bacterial resistance. The project is supported by various consortia, with international funding and cooperation, and is being deployed for the first time in Morocco under the UEMF-MicroMondeMaroc initiative.



Signing of the financing agreement for the "Factory Pilot School 4.0" project co-financed by the KFW subsidiary, the Investment Facility for Employment (IFE)



On July 2, 2024, the EuroMed University of Fez (UEMF) and the Investment Facility for Employment (IFE) signed a financing agreement for the Pilot School Factory 4.0. This project, co-financed by the IFE (37.58 million DH, or 3.51 M ε) and I'UEMF (own contribution of 30%), mobilizes a total investment of 53.2 million DH (4.97 M ε) to build a training centeresaye hasindustry 4.0.

This center, which is expected to open in September 2026, will train 585 graduates and strengthen the skills of more than 1,100 professionals in its first three years of operation, creating 541 new jobs. It is part of the national digital transformation strategy and aims to support Morocco's industrial growth, particularly in the Fez-Meknes region, by offering specialized training for young graduates and professionals.

This signature marks the beginning of several similar projects financed by the IFE, in partnership with Moroccan institutional and industrial players, as part of the development of training infrastructures for the industry of tomorrow.
