SDG1 Report: No Poverty

UEMF is committed to the fight against poverty and involves its entire community in helping to solve this problem through various social actions.

Communication

This work begins with communication with families and individuals from poor backgrounds in order to inform them of:

- UEMF's quality training and education offerings.
- Scholarships and insurance
- Student living conditions

Communication activities are numerous and involve participation in:

- student fairs in all regions of the country and in particular the most disadvantaged
- mobile caravans co-organized with NGOs in rural and hard-to-reach areas

To this end, the UEMF has signed several agreements with NGOs and foundations to provide them with merit scholarships for candidates from disadvantaged backgrounds. These scholarships are in the form of free or partially free teaching places for the entire duration of the studies.

UEMF scholarships

- Our University was created as a non-profit association called a Foundation and enjoying public utility. It does not have shareholders, but rather contributors and donors.
- Our mission is public and our management style is private, without profit motive.
- Our primary objective is to offer excellent higher education and research programs that meet the highest international standards.
- Our aim is to make the Euromed University of Fez accessible to a greater number of students, by establishing several categories of scholarships:
 1. Excellence scholarships for brilliant students who have distinguished themselves through the excellence of their academic record, regardless of family income;
 2. Merit scholarships for students from low-income backgrounds with a very good academic record;
 3. Solidarity grants covering tuition, residence and catering fees for good students from disadvantaged backgrounds;
 4. "Africa" scholarships for good sub-Saharan students with low incomes;
 5. Total exemption from tuition fees for all doctoral students;
 6. Attractive and competitive living allowances for doctoral students 5000Dh net / month minimum;
 7. Attractive and competitive scholarships for postdoctoral researchers between 13,000 and 25,000 Dh net / month
- All scholarships are reviewed by a committee that acts in a rigorous, transparent and fair manner and no other considerations may interfere with the sine qua non criteria of excellence.

- For the 2022/2023 academic year, several scholarships have been awarded to students, to partially or fully cover tuition, residence and catering fees for the various programs offered.

Tuition grants

For each of the two categories (Excellence and Merit), there are four types of scholarship:

1. Scholarship to cover 100% of registration and tuition fees
2. Scholarship to cover 75% of registration and tuition fees
3. Scholarship to cover 50% of registration and tuition fees
4. Scholarship to cover 25% of registration and tuition fees

Total number of students: 3000 in 2022-2023, more than half of whom are scholarship holders.

Solidarity grants

The UEMF awards solidarity grants covering up to 100% of residence and catering costs for students with a good academic record and from disadvantaged backgrounds.

The UEMF is strongly involved in its local, regional and national environment and works towards solidarity by:

1. Providing access to educational resources for those not studying at university – for example, computers, bibliographic works, online courses and access to conferences;
2. Organizing events at the university open to the general public: public lectures, community educational events;
3. Traveling to local and regional schools for awareness-raising activities, student-run social and volunteer projects or to improve access to basic services (food, housing, transportation).

Donations obtained by UEMF for the benefit of scholarship students

A €5 million donation from the EU through the Competitiveness and Green Growth Support Programme (PACC) aimed at supporting the University's scholarship policy for equitable access for deserving students to excellent higher education and also the promotion of training courses in green professions

Loan options

Students enrolled at UEMF have the option of taking out a student loan with an exceptional interest rate of 2% and only repaying it from the sixth year, i.e. one year after obtaining a Master's degree or equivalent to Bac+5.

Scholarships for students from low-income countries

UEMF places particular importance on training students from friendly low-income countries. To this end, the university has the services of a presidential advisor to:

- Develop and identify opportunities for UEMF partnerships with public and private institutions, particularly on the African continent.

- Develop and strengthen cultural, scientific and economic relations with partner countries, particularly within the framework of South-South cooperation;
- Represent the University at professional events such as trade fairs and international events.
- Ensure the implementation of support measures (sources of funding, accommodation, internships, etc.) taken by the UEMF to facilitate and improve the reception and recruitment of students from low-income countries.

Several agreements are operational to provide scholarships to African students, including those signed with:

Mobility grants abroad

For our students who wish to complete part of their studies abroad, the cost of their international mobility can be partially covered by scholarship programs, depending on the destinations and types of mobility, such as:

- The ERASMUS program and in particular K107 which has enabled dozens of mobility opportunities for engineering students from INSA EM;
- Dual degree agreements (example Master of Business Law with the Sorbonne Law School);
- EMADU agreements with the Architecture departments of the universities of Mons (Belgium) and Florence (Italy).

Health and Hygiene

- The provision of medical and paramedical care: availability of an infirmary and paramedical staff;
- Monitoring the hygiene status of university premises;
- Health education;
- Organization of health awareness and information campaigns;
- Monitoring the state of food hygiene and hygiene and safety in the university environment.

Local Startup Help

Providing assistance to the local community by supporting the start-up of sustainable businesses through education or relevant resources (mentoring programs, training workshops, open access to university facilities). 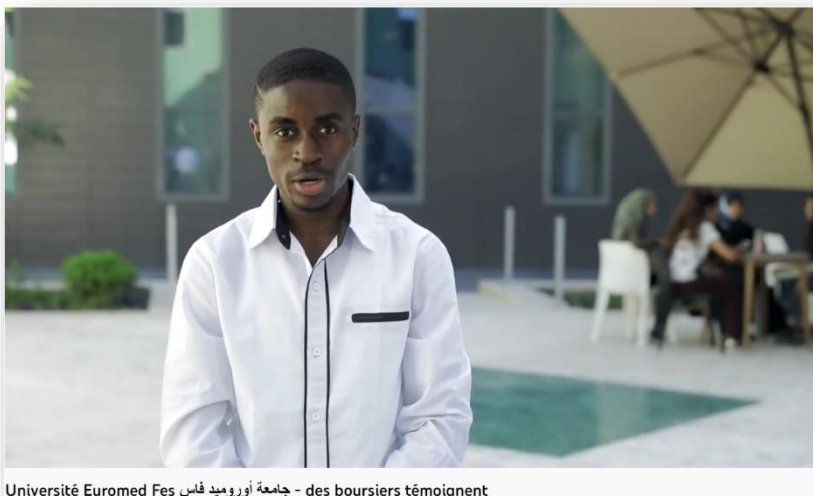

Actions during Covid 19

In response to the coronavirus pandemic, the EU has made an additional donation of 5.4 million dirhams to theEuroMed University of Fez(UEMF), intended for the acquisition of computer and laboratory equipment. This support has enabled the University to ensure educational continuity for its scholarship students and to manufacture medical protective equipment.

- A €500,000 donation from the European Union for the acquisition of IT equipment (computers, internet connection keys and subscriptions) and laboratory equipment (3D printers). This equipment has enabled the university to ensure educational continuity for 420 of its scholarship students who are isolated or not equipped with a computer, and to manufacture medical protection equipment to combat the Covid-19 pandemic in Morocco.

Offers laptops to scholarship holders

ReadEuromed University of Fez, with the financial support of the European Union, offered all its scholarship holders magnificent new PCs (HP core i5 8th Gen) accompanied by 4G keys and a one-year internet subscription. A total of 420 kits were distributed, including 26 to Sanady scholarship holders. This great initiative will allow scholarship students to overcome the difficulties linked to the lack of equipment during this period of confinement and to continue this school year in the best possible way.

- The establishment of aid for students and staff from disaster areas.

2024: Euromed University of Fez at the heart of action for the SDGs

Launch of the first Bootcamp of the Tech4Farmers program at the Euromed University of Fez



From June 10 to 12, a bootcamp brought together AgriTech innovators supported by the French Development Agency (AFD) as part of the "Tamkin LiTanmia" project, in partnership with the Fez-Meknes Regional AgriTech Innovation and Entrepreneurship Hub. Participants included promising startups such as DeepLeaf, Jafife, ARWA Solutions, and Agri-bOT, each bringing their expertise to transform agriculture sustainably.

The first day was dedicated to a welcome, introductions to Design Thinking, and discussions with experts. The second day explored project development and prototyping, including role-plays to understand user needs and funding opportunities. Finally, the third day focused on partnerships, with feedback and individual coaching sessions. This program provided startups with a platform to innovate, strengthen synergies, and contribute to the region's sustainable development.

The Rotaract club organized an ophthalmic medical campaign for the benefit of 100 young students of a school in Kansara, Moulay Yaacoub region



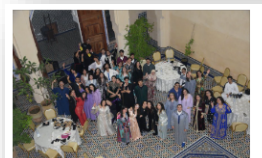
April 20th, 2024

UEMF students make the voices of young Africans and Euro-Mediterraneans heard before the Parliamentary Assembly of the Union for the Mediterranean



On February 14, 2024, students from the Euromed University of Fez organized a summit under the theme "Euro-Mediterranean and Transatlantic Openness" with more than 200 participants from 30 countries. This summit addressed topics such as energy ethics, sustainable development, transportation, climate change, and African challenges.

The summit culminated in the Call for Investment in the Future, read out on February 16 at the 8th Summit of Speakers of Parliaments of the Union for the Mediterranean. This call underscores the need to strengthen cooperation between Europe and Africa through concrete projects, allocate pledged funds for climate resilience, and support initiatives such as the Nigeria-Morocco gas pipeline.

The students also welcomed Morocco's initiatives for economic integration, infrastructure, and education in Africa, while calling for a "Marshall Plan" for education and research in Africa as an investment in the future to combat poverty, terrorism, and illegal immigration.

A meal, a smile – A solidarity action from the Elite Club

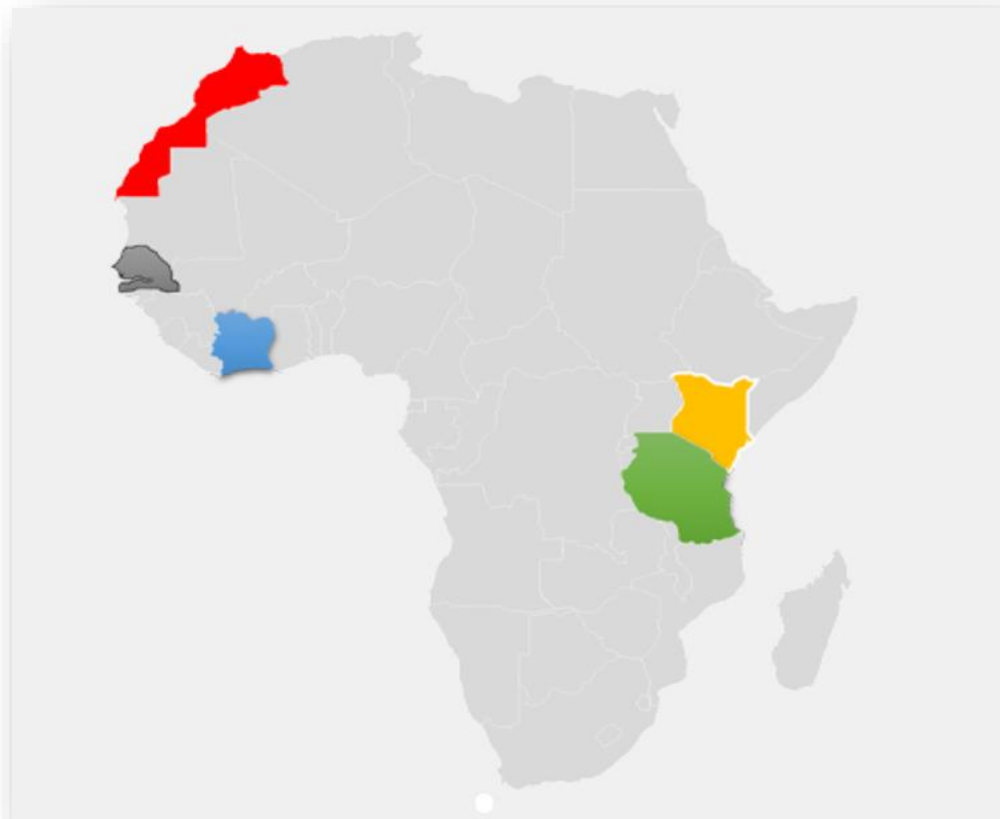
The club also organized a collective iftar, which brought together more than 100 participants, promoting a moment of sharing and conviviality.
