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SDG 10 Report: Reduced Inequalities

Introduction

Morocco has ratified all UN conventions relating to inclusion and diversity. As such, Morocco recognizes the right of vulnerable people to education and is committed to developing inclusive environments that facilitate their full and equal participation in the education system and, more broadly, in community life. The Constitution of the Kingdom of Morocco of July 1, 2011, places these issues at the heart of the issues of individual rights and freedoms.

Furthermore, the Higher Council for Education, Training and Scientific Research (CSEFRS) has developed the Strategic Vision 2015-2030. The latter's recommendations converge towards a fair, high-quality school that promotes the advancement of individuals and tends towards the development of a genuine strategy for inclusion and diversity.

The creation of the Euromed University of Fez (UEMF) is the result of a Royal Initiative and is fully in line with the recommendations set out. Its objective is to establish in Fez a platform for intercultural dialogue, exchange & cooperation between the two shores of the Mediterranean with a natural extension to sub-Saharan Africa. The UEMF is a non-profit Foundation with public utility status and is certified by the Union for the Mediterranean (UfM) with the support of its 43 member countries. The UEMF is placed under the High Honorary Presidency of His Majesty King Mohammed VI and its degrees (MS. BS. MBA & Ph.D.) are recognized by the Moroccan State and all its courses have been accredited by the national quality assurance agency.

Diversity of the UEMF community

UEMF strives to welcome diverse and sometimes distant audiences in order to contribute to the construction of an egalitarian and tolerant society. It makes its admissions procedures more inclusive, to facilitate access to higher education for all by reducing financial barriers and promoting social and cultural inclusion and diversity on its campus.

Students, academic & administrative staff and local partners:

Inclusion: The university has over 3,000 students (54% women) and this number will reach 7,000 by 2026. In 2022-2023, students represent over 30 nationalities: North Africa: Morocco, Algeria, Tunisia, Egypt; Sub-Saharan countries: Senegal, Ivory Coast, Republic of Congo, Benin, Mali, Gabon, Burkina Faso, Comoros, Nigeria, Cameroon, Ethiopia, Tanzania, Togo, Ghana, Guinea, Mauritius, Rwanda; Europe: France, Spain, Italy, Portugal, Ukraine; Americas: Haiti; Middle East: Iraq, Syria. Administrative and teaching members come from 16 different countries: Morocco, Algeria, Tunisia, France, Spain, Italy, Portugal, Ukraine, Poland, Germany, Belgium, Russia, USA, Canada, Peru, Colombia


The goal is not only to train experts who master the most modern knowledge and techniques and technologies, but also and above all to train citizens aware of their rights, their duties and imbued with universal and multidimensional values in terms of openness, living together, knowing how to be, critical thinking and respect for others and the environment. In addition, all our students receive training throughout their studies on soft skills, study skills, life skills, professional skills and entrepreneurial skills.



Values

The UEMF:





- is open to the world and promotes the values of inclusion, moderation, tolerance, interculturality and sharing;
- is open to all students and staff, national and international, without discrimination based on origin, family situation, gender, disability or belief;
- is based on equal opportunities;
- advocates gender equality and implements a proactive policy of including as many women as possible as well as people with reduced capacities;
- recognizes and rewards excellence through evaluation at all levels, both top-down and bottom-up;
- promotes critical thinking, rationality, civic values, commitment, a sense of duty and common interest, as well as respect for others and the environment;
- encourages initiative, entrepreneurship, innovation and mastery of languages and cultures;
- has social responsibility and offers scholarships, accommodation and food to the best students from low-income families and sub-Saharan Africa.

UEMF Eco-campus

UEMF has an Eco-Campus designed to the highest international standards with state-of-the-art teaching and research facilities. Societal policy

The UEMF's societal policy (periodically revised) advocates:

- Equal opportunities in employment, career development, access to education and lifelong learning
- Parity, pay equity: achieve and maintain parity in numbers of men and women, using positive discrimination in cases of equality of profiles and skills.
- Banishment of all discrimination based on social rank, gender, belief, age, ethnic origin, immigration status or disability.
- Welcoming foreign students, particularly from sub-Saharan Africa: offering merit scholarships (accommodation, food, tuition fees, etc.) for better integration, inclusion and success. African students are active and organized within a dynamic association (African day, forums, product exhibitions, arts and culture, sports, etc.) (https://greatyop.com/asric-and-uemf-scholarships/)
- Inclusion of disadvantaged people, people with disabilities and immigrants:

1. all buildings and all premises within the University buildings are accessible to PRM (Persons with Reduced Mobility) and all stairs and elevators are equipped with signage written in Braille for the blind and visually impaired;

2. on all floors and in all areas of the University, sanitary facilities complying with international standards are made available to people with reduced mobility;





- 3. in all parking areas, specific spaces are reserved for people with reduced mobility and significant fines are applied to anyone who parks there without the right to do so;
- 4. adapted accommodation is made available to students with disabilities and in cases of severe disability, the University authorizes a family member to stay with the disabled student.
- 5. a personalized service for the disabled, including a shuttle (transport by electric car) from the campus gate to the teaching rooms. Production of adapted course materials and application of the one-third time rule during assessments;

Gender policy

The University has a Women and Men Equality Charter shared and validated by its authorities.

Positive discrimination towards women is applied: access to studies, employment, promotion, high positions, etc.

Discrimination against women or moral or sexual harassment are severely punished.

Discrimination of any kind whatsoever, and especially against women, is prohibited from the practices and operations of the University.

Any person who:

- 1. making derogatory remarks towards women regarding:
- a. physical appearance, b. style of dress, c. manner of being, speaking and behaving
- 2. disadvantaging women in: a. the exercise of their functions, b. access to responsibilities when they have the required qualifications and skills, c. staff evaluations,
- d. the awarding of grades and academic assessments for female students;
- 3. exercising moral or physical harassment.

Reproducibility

The Tawesna Fez club organized an Amazigh theme day on February 15, 2023. This rich day, both cultural and artistic in nature, aimed to promote Amazigh culture through an exhibition of books, carpets and crafts, an Ahidous animation with the Amasasa troupe as well as performances of contemporary songs representing the different regions and facets of Amazigh culture.

The event was an opportunity to showcase the cultural richness of Morocco to members of the UEMF community and to various students from several countries around the world.





During his speech, the President of Euromed University, Mostapha Bousmina, noted that students and lecturers currently represent 43 nationalities who meet every day on campus, work together and some are shaping a common future.

He then reviewed the university's major projects, whose surface area will soon increase from 50 hectares to 120 hectares with the construction of a university hospital, a faculty of





medicine which will be operational from next September, a faculty of dentistry and a nursing training center.

He also mentioned the Fez Smart Factory project, based on Industry 4.0, which will be completed soon, as well as the second phase of the campus, which includes a conference center that can accommodate around 3,500 people, a large library, a sports complex with an Olympic swimming pool and a FIFA-standard football pitch, in addition to shops, a minimarket, bookstores, cafes and restaurants, a beauty salon, a pharmacy, etc.





"Transregionalism and National Interest: An Analysis of the Challenges and Opportunities of Morocco's Membership of ECOWAS".

Morocco's bid to join ECOWAS, initiated in 2017, has encountered several challenges despite initial support. This thesis examines the interests and concerns of ECOWAS member states that shape the accession process. It highlights Morocco's strong historical, cultural, and economic ties with West Africa, but also notes that national interests, identity concerns, and the lack of a legal framework hinder its membership. The study argues that Morocco offers strategic advantages—such as infrastructure, security cooperation, and economic development—and recommends enhancing diplomatic efforts, aligning trade policies, and using soft power. Ultimately, it suggests that Morocco's inclusion could reshape African regionalism by prioritizing economic cooperation over traditional geographic boundaries.

This agreement aims to strengthen language teaching with certification through the UEMF language center, in line with academic and professional needs.

The collaboration also includes joint cultural programming for the university community and the general public. Thanks to its modern infrastructure, such as a 2,000-seat agora and cultural spaces under construction (theatre and cinema), the UEMF is positioning itself as a major player in educational and cultural cooperation. This partnership illustrates the shared commitment to intercultural dialogue and the influence of Franco-Moroccan cooperation.

[Tribune] Wage inequality in Morocco: three months of "free" work for women



According to a report by the High Commission for Planning, published in 2024, the wage gap between men and women reached 23%. This means that in 2024, Moroccan women symbolically worked "for free" from October 8 until the end of the year. This observation highlights the urgent need for concrete action to reduce these inequalities and ensure true pay equity. This represents nearly three months of unpaid work compared to men, an alarming inequality that remains largely ignored in the public debate.

His latest film, The Slave, boldly addresses the issue of voluntary enslavement through the journey of Ibrahim, a young man in search of a master. The power of the story also lies in the performances of its actors, notably Saad Mouaffak in the lead role, accompanied by Omar Lotfi, Sahar Seddiki, Naima Ilyas, Ismail Abou-El-Kanater, Mohamed El Atir, and Hajar Chergui.

The meeting concluded with a rich exchange with the students, teachers and guests present, around the themes raised by the film and the contemporary issues of Moroccan cinema.



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Medical-Dental Caravan in Sebaa Rouadi





School health caravan in Aouzay

Medical-Dental Caravan in Dar Abkhtie



As part of its commitment to access to healthcare in remote areas, the Elite Club of the Euromed University of Fez organized a large-scale medical and dental caravan in Dar Abkhtie. - 50m boys: 1st place (gold medal) and 3rd place (bronze medal).
- 50m girls: 2nd place (silver medal) and 3rd place (bronze medal).
- Mixed relay: 1st place (gold medal).

At the end of this event, the Euromed University of Fez was elected "Best Delegation" by the organizers, an accolade that testifies to the commitment, team spirit and excellence of our students.

Solidarity distribution and collective iftar - Hands Club









Art Workshop for Autistic Children - Rotaract Club




The Rotaract Club, in partnership with the National Center for the Disabled in Fez, organized an art workshop for autistic children.



A blood donation campaign is being organized by the UEMF Rotaract Club on September 25 and 26 in partnership with the Moroccan blood and blood derivatives agency.






