## SDG 16 Report: Peace, Justice and Strong Institutions


#### Introduction

The UEMF places the following principles and values at the heart of its operating method:

- openness to the world (languages, cultures, etc.), inclusion, moderation, tolerance, interculturality and sharing;
- fight against all discrimination based on origin, family situation, gender (SDG5 report), disability or belief;
- equity and the fight against inequalities (SDG 10 report)
- equality of opportunity, gender and opportunities;
- citizenship based on civic-mindedness, civility, commitment, a sense of duty and common interest, as well as respect for others and the environment;
- mediation and conflict resolution.

### **UEMF Governance**

The Euromed University of Fez (UEMF) is a non-profit organization (according to the Dahir of 1958), called a Foundation. It enjoys the status of Public Utility and is placed under the High Honorary Presidency of His Majesty the King, Mohammed VI.



### The Governance and Management bodies are:

- 1. The General Assembly
- 2. The Steering, Monitoring and Development Council (COSD) also called the Board of Directors (CA)
- 3. The Chancellor





- 4. The Foundation Office
- 5. The President of the University
- 6. The University Council
- 7. The Scientific Council

The UEMF's governing bodies, as well as all its components (establishments, directorates, centers, etc.), work in a democratic, participatory, and inclusive team spirit, and advocate responsibility, transparency, and accountability. The bodies' reports and decisions are shared and communicated to stakeholders.

The internal regulations of the UEMF and its institutions are validated by the authorities and communicated to all stakeholders. The regulations are based on national legislation, respect for citizens' rights, and the Kingdom's constitution. The regulations specify the method of designating and/or electing members of the authorities.

The UEMF has charters and policies validated by the Presidency: social and societal responsibility, energy efficiency, digital responsibility, quality assurance, gender equality, fight against discrimination, etc.

She makes a great effort to raise awareness in the community about these policies and ensures that everyone knows their rights and responsibilities, in a framework of serenity and mutual respect.

### Mediator

The mediator's mission is to contribute to the establishment of a calm, pleasant, and respectful working environment. He or she assists in the amicable resolution of conflicts between the parties involved in a dispute.

#### **Prerogatives**

In the event of a conflict, the university community (teachers, researchers, students, and administrative and support staff) may refer the matter to the mediator, who will examine the case to ensure that its content falls within his or her jurisdiction. If the matter is inadmissible, the mediator will inform the President of the University or may also redirect the matter to the appropriate departments. He or she may conduct investigations, meet with all parties individually and/or collectively, and make recommendations to the parties, who are free to implement them or not.

In a spirit of conflict prevention and to help with team cohesion, he is also responsible for holding meetings with the various departments to help establish a calm and cordial working environment.

The Mediator acts with complete independence, transparency and discretion. He is not vested with any power of decision, injunction or coercion.

He reports on his mission to the President of the UEMF and prepares an annual activity report in compliance with the rules of discretion and confidentiality.





Cases that cannot be subject to mediation:

- serious cases rather falling under the jurisdiction of the courts;
- conflict situation which is not within the scope of work;
- one of the parties does not wish to mediate;
- academic situations which are more the responsibility of the Establishments (cases of student failure, grades, exams, internships, etc.) or the responsibility of the Human Resources Department.

### **Bachelor's Degree in Political and Legal Sciences**

The Bachelor's degree in Political and Legal Sciences provides general knowledge in the field of social sciences, politics and law, which gradually become more specialized in order to prepare students for one of the master's degrees in the discipline or other related specialties, by providing tools for analyzing and deciphering contemporary political realities in the Euro-Mediterranean.

This degree operates by putting theories and data from political and legal sciences into perspective through a Euro-Mediterranean contextualization and comparisons on a global scale.

The objective of the Bachelor's degree in political and legal sciences is to enable students to:

- To identify and understand the political, economic, administrative and social actors at the local, national, Euro-Mediterranean and global levels.
- To understand the principles of analysis of the contemporary world relating to political regimes, legal and social systems and national and international conflicts.
- To master the mechanisms for analyzing the main issues of the contemporary world, such as environmental problems, development and conflicts.
- To know how to mobilize the concepts and methods of different disciplines to understand and analyze the different aspects of the contemporary world.

### Master's in Mediterranean and African Politics

The Master's in Mediterranean and African Politics is a multidisciplinary course (law, economics, geopolitics, strategy, international peace and security, diplomacy, environment, energy, development, negotiations, etc.) and combines theoretical and methodological dimensions.

With a professional vocation, it aims to provide the explanatory tools essential for understanding international phenomena. It is based on cutting-edge training provided by both international teachers and practitioners.

Among the objectives of this training, we find:

- Deepening knowledge of politics and international law;
- The appropriation of conceptual and technical instruments relating to international relations and diplomacy by grasping the characteristics and constraints of practices specific to the Euromed and African space;





- The perception of the issues, challenges and opportunities in the formation of foreign policies, international cooperation and public policy mechanisms adopted by state orders
- Mastery of the dimensions of cooperation and development in Africa and the Euro-Mediterranean:
- Understanding the dynamics of conflicts and the processes of their resolution;
- Knowledge of international security issues and challenges;
- The ability to design an appropriate framework for analyzing a problem and interpreting the data collected; ability to present the state of knowledge and debates on a situation or problem relating to international relations.

The Euromed University of Fez (UEMF) is hosting, from November 21 to 23, 2022, the youth event of the 9th World Forum of the United Nations Alliance of Civilizations (UNAOC) which is being held in Fez.

The World Forum of the United Nations Alliance of Civilizations is being held for the first time on the African continent. Due to the leadership of His Majesty King Mohammed VI, regarding world peace, the promotion of intercultural and intercultural dialogue, living together and inclusion, this Forum is being held in Morocco and particularly in the spiritual and ancestral city of Fez, which is home to the oldest university in the world, still in operation, the Al Qarawiyine University, which was the rear base of the golden age of Muslim civilization in Andalusia by providing and sharing science and knowledge with the Iberian Peninsula and by extension with Europe and the world.

Miguel Ángel Moratinos Cuyaubé, United Nations High Representative for the Alliance of Civilizations



As part of the 9th World Forum of the United Nations Alliance of Civilizations (UNAOC) held in Fez from November 21 to 24, Mr. Miguel Ángel Moratinos Cuyaubé visited the UEMF on the occasion of the youth forum held at the Euromed University of Fez on the sidelines of this event.





Mr. Moratinos Cuyaubé has devoted his professional and political career to international relations and development cooperation, having notably held the positions of Minister of Foreign Affairs and Cooperation (2004-2010), presided over the United Nations Security Council and held the presidencies-in-office of the Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe (OSCE), the Council of Europe and the Council of the European Union.

Mr. Moratinos Cuyaubé has also held several positions at the national level, including Deputy Director General for North Africa (1987-1991), Director of the Institute for Cooperation with the Arab World (1991-1993) and Director General for Foreign Policy in Africa and the Middle East (1993-1996). He also participated in the organization, in 1992, of the Madrid Conference for Peace in the Middle East.

He began his diplomatic career as Head of the Coordination Section for Eastern Europe (1977-1980). He was subsequently appointed First Secretary and then Chargé d'affaires of the Spanish Embassy in the former Yugoslavia (1980-1984), and then Political Counsellor in Morocco (1984-1987). After serving as Spanish Ambassador to Israel in 1996, Mr. Moratinos Cuyaubé was appointed by the European Union as Special Representative for the Middle East Peace Process (1996-2003), a position in which he promoted peace agreements and acted, on behalf of the European Union, to promote Israeli-Arab dialogue.

He initiated and organized the Fez forums on the Alliance of Civilizations and those on the Union for the Mediterranean. Prof. Abdelhak Azzouzi has also written about thirty books, including nine volumes on the Alliance of Civilizations and cultural diversity. He has published more than 1,500 international chronicles. He is a consultant to several national and international organizations. He has received several





international distinctions and awards, including that of the Mediterranean Parliamentary Assembly for his commitment to bringing the two shores of the Mediterranean closer together.

As part of the 2023-2024 activities of the ICESCO-EUROMED Chair "Arts, Societies and CIVILIZATIONS", a Master class was organized on Wednesday, October 18, 2023, led by Ms. Rajae Talbi (poet, writer and translator) on the theme "Translation and dialogue of cultures".

The debate developed from the reflection she initiated, was polarized around crucial questions: 1. the role of Translation in the construction of peace, the rise of interculturality, the transmission of knowledge. 2. The practice of translation as work on the imagination of the self and the perception of the other. 3. Translation and its requirements in relation to the translator and the reader.

The open debate with the students of the Translation department allowed for an even richer extension of these lines of thought, highlighting among other things the problems of Translation faced with the challenges of artificial intelligence, of Translation confronted with the mutations of languages as they undergo today the effects of social media, the isolation in which the translator finds himself forced to constantly invent his own tools.

This Master class actively functioned as a true laboratory for analyzing the mechanisms of Translation and its epistemological foundations.

### 2024: Euromed University of Fez at the heart of action for the SDGs

Prof. James F. Hollifield at the Euromed University of Fez: "The Challenge of Forced Migration and Human Displacement"



On May 30, 2024, the Euromed University of Fez hosted Professor James F. Hollifield for a lecture on migration governance and global humanitarian crises. A migration expert and member of the Council on Foreign Relations, Professor Hollifield shared his expertise on migration policies and governance dilemmas. He highlighted the challenges states face in balancing the security and human rights of forced migrants.

Professor Hollifield, Ora Nixon Arnold Professor of International Political Economy and Director of the Tower Center at Southern Methodist University, provided valuable insights from his experience as an advisor to various governments and consultant for international organizations such as the United Nations and the World Bank. He discussed the rise of forced migration and its global impact.

This conference provided UEMF students and research professors with an in-depth understanding of the issues surrounding forced migration, while fostering constructive dialogue on ethical and effective state responses. It is part of the activities of the UEMF Alliance of Civilizations Chair, which aims to strengthen intellectual momentum and stimulate student reflection.

The UNESCO Chair of the Euromed University of Fez "Mediterranean Interculturalities" organized on May 24, 2024 an international conference on the theme: "Mediterranean and Interculturalities: realities of today and challenges of the future".

In the presence of Prof. Mansour M'Henni, special guest of this event held within the Ecocampus, a range of participants highlighted different avenues according to which the question of interculturality can constitute a lever for building a Mediterranean reconciled with itself, its peoples and its societies. Thus, the emphasis was placed on the terminologies to be developed to better think of the Mediterranean as a space, historical depth and promise of the future, by approaching the subject from different prisms (in French, English and Spanish).

Likewise, the approaches used, using multiple media (crafts, magazines, literary texts, migration, imagination, communication, etc.), have shown the importance that should be given to training in intercultural values in order to combat exclusion, dogmatism and other forms of extremism that prevent the re-establishment of a Mediterranean considered as a memory of the future.

### Professor ACHACHI's conference on the foundations of Russian geopolitics



The speaker Dr. ACHACHI, once again hosted a large-scale conference on Russian geopolitics within the framework of the Wednesdays of Philosophy, at the eco-campus of the Euromed University of Fez on May 22, 2024.

During this session, Prof. ACHACHI illustrated the geopolitical evolution of Russia, which intended to access warm seas between the 18th century and the beginning of the 20th century as a pragmatic reaction to the principality of the capital Moscow representing a partitioned steppe land. As a result, Russia wanted to conquer the maximum number of regions and territories to create a regional buffer. Subsequently, Mr. ACHACHI mentioned the concept of the "Russian world" which is added to the West/East logic in order to escape an intrinsic encirclement.

The particularity of this meeting lies in its special momentum because it represents the closing of a cycle of conferences that has crisscrossed the entire academic year and has just been completed by means of a conference that deals with a very formidable topical subject which allowed the audience represented by students, doctoral students and professors, to ask many questions in order to assimilate the current geopolitical situation.



#### Doctoral thesis defense in Artificial Intelligence by Ms. Yasmine GHAZLANE



This doctoral thesis explores anti-drone technology by addressing the gaps in current defense mechanisms against drone proliferation. It proposes a novel anti-drone architecture based on artificial intelligence, blockchain, multi-agent systems, and expert systems. An Albased electromagnetic neutralization model is developed to counter harmful drones in real time. Real-time detection and identification models, using advanced algorithms and deep learning techniques, are created to quickly identify aerial targets. The thesis also focuses on distinguishing between drones and other aerial targets, such as birds, by developing a "friend or foe" classification model. It also studies the impact of model depth on their classification performance. The "friend or foe" model is integrated into the overall system with a real-time detection module to improve the effectiveness, accuracy, adaptability, and robustness of the anti-drone system in dynamic and complex environments.

#### Between Cordoba and Marrakech: a barzakh between Ibn Rochd and Averroes



During the April 17 conference, organized as part of the activities of the UNESCO-EUROMED Chair "Mediterranean Interculturalities" and the "Philosophy Wednesdays" at the Ecocampus, Professor Driss Ksikes explored the rationalist thought of Ibn Rochd (Averroes) through the theme "Between Cordoba and Marrakech: A Barzakh between Ibn Rochd and Averroes." Ksikes, an award-winning writer and playwright, presented excerpts from his novel "At the Strait of Averroes," blending fiction and reality to revisit the transfer of Ibn Rochd's physical and spiritual traces between Marrakech and Cordoba. The conference highlighted how Averroes, by appropriating Aristotle's legacy, created a rupture with both the West and the East, finding himself misunderstood and misunderstood by both. Driss Ksikes emphasized the importance of re-examining Ibn Rochd's thought, which had become alien to dominant ideologies, for its timelessness and relevance today. The exchange with the audience opened up new philosophical perspectives, consolidating the impact of this enriching meeting.


The meeting concluded with a rich exchange with the students, teachers and guests present, around the themes raised by the film and the contemporary issues of Moroccan cinema.



#### Towards better local governance: UEMF equips municipal elected officials



As part of its ongoing efforts to build the capacity of local stakeholders and improve the performance of public services, the Euromed University of Fez, under the supervision of the Fez-Meknes Regional Council, organized a training workshop on the theme of administrative policing on Wednesday, May 14 and Thursday, May 15. The workshop also provided an opportunity to delve deeper into the legal and regulatory frameworks governing the missions of the administrative police, to examine the municipality's intervention mechanisms, its areas of action, as well as the principles of balance between the preservation of public order and respect for individual rights.

This initiative confirms the importance of continuing education as a key lever for modernizing local administration, improving the quality of public services, and strengthening trust between citizens and elected institutions. This workshop thus illustrates the shared commitment of the Euromed University of Fez and the Fez-Meknes Regional Council to establish an innovative training model, based on the convergence of academic knowledge and the reality on the ground, in the service of sustainable and effective local development.

# Doctoral Thesis Defense in "Information and Communication Sciences" by Mr. Anoire EL ATTARI




This research offers a retrospective analysis of the role of Moroccan media during the Covid-19 crisis, focusing on their adaptation strategies and their influence on public perceptions and behaviors. By adopting a mixed methodology combining a thematic analysis of 30 semi-structured interviews and a statistical analysis of the responses of 562 participants to a questionnaire, the study highlights how journalists faced challenges such as disinformation, mobility restrictions, and the tension between speed and accuracy of information. The results highlight the essential role of the media as a relay of reliable information and confirm the impact of media consumption on preventive behaviors. Finally, the study makes theoretical and practical recommendations regarding communication in times of crisis, media literacy, and the use of technologies to combat disinformation during emergency situations.

# Doctoral Thesis Defense in "International Relations" by Mr. Othman SQALLI HOUSSAINI




