SDG17 Report: Partnerships for the Goals

Introduction

The UEMF is a partnership project. Itemanates from the Royal Initiative with the desire to create in Fez a framework for higher education and research based on intercultural dialogue, exchange and cooperation between the two shores of the Mediterranean, with a natural extension towards Sub-Saharan Africa, while offering excellent training and conducting very high-level scientific research in close connection with the socio-economic world. UEMF welcomes more than 35 nationalities between students and professors and therefore constitutes a multicultural platform.

The Moroccan government has significantly supported the implementation of the UEMF through subsidies for its operation and for the land base for its eco-campus as well as for its investments.

The UEMF also benefited from donations from the European Union and a loan of 50% of its investments from the European Investment Bank and also from support from the Union for the Mediterranean.

Bachelor's Degree in Translation and International Relations

It is a multidisciplinary program combining various contributions from the humanities, social sciences, as well as legal and political sciences. Euromed University of Fez is the first and only university in Morocco to offer this original and innovative academic format.

Today's global challenges require professionals with a sound understanding of international institutions and organizations, as well as a solid grounding in the humanities, enabling them to gain an in-depth understanding of the evolution and complexity of societies. The Bachelor's degree in Translation and International Relations is a university degree that meets this need. It integrates various fields of knowledge and aims to equip students with skills useful for analyzing the complex problems of our time.

This program offers solid training in translation and international relations, complemented by legal, economic and sociological subjects and skills.



THE International Ranking of the best universities in the world: UEMF presents itself with eight other Moroccan universities



The THE ranking is based on a multidimensional analysis of higher education institutions through their achievement of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals, as measured by Thomson Reuters and Elsevier. It is noteworthy that recently established universities, such as the Euromed University of Fez and the International University of Rabat, rank higher than other major national universities.

It is a global ranking, by subject and reputation, and it also provides regional and national rankings. Along with the Shanghai and QS rankings, the THE ranking is one of the most influential university rankings worldwide.

The 2022 ranking covered universities from 106 countries. Eight Moroccan universities are ranked among the top 1,000 universities in this global ranking this year. Nationally, the UEMF ranking is as follows:

Among these projects, an incubator will be set up within the Euromed University of Fez and will allow project leaders to create their start-ups in an innovative environment promoting productivity and the development of know-how.

The University also signed a partnership agreement with the Wilaya of the region, the Regional Council, Sidi Mohamed Ben Abdellah University, Moulay Ismail University of Meknes and Al Akhawayn University of Ifrane. This agreement aims to implement a project to support research and innovation in the digital field and will contribute to preparing the region for the exploitation of technologies of the Internet of Things, robotics and cobotics, additive manufacturing and artificial intelligence.

Bousmina represented the Euromed University of Fez during the signing ceremony of the contracts to support the Al Khawarizmi artificial intelligence program under the aegis of:


- Mr. Said Amzazi, Minister of National Education, Vocational Training, Higher Education and Scientific Research;

During this meeting, 45 eligible projects were selected according to well-defined criteria and were then evaluated by CNRS experts for funding. As a reminder, the "Al Khawarizmi" program has a budget of 50 million Dhs, allocated 70% by the Department of National Education and 30% by the ADD.

Both parties mutually agree to develop partnership projects with high added value, in particular through the development of training programs, training of trainers, support for entrepreneurship and continuing education, as well as participation in research projects and end-of-training projects and the joint development of training projects for the benefit of African partner countries.

UEMF's involvement through this new partnership project confirms its commitment to supporting training structures in centers of excellence that develop training and research programs, promoting innovation. Thanks to its eco-campus designed to the highest international standards, UEMF will allow the "City of Trades and Skills" of the Fez-Meknes Region, which aims to be a center of excellence, to have access to its technological platforms, designed to international standards, in particular those dedicated to digital engineering and artificial intelligence, 3D printing, 4.0 technology, nanotechnologies, renewable energies, biotechnology and biomedicine.

The National Commission for the Control of Personal Data Protection also intends to support the UEMF in the process of compliance with Law 09-08.

The UEMF, for its part, will organize training sessions for trainers on the protection of personal data by the CNDP.

The New Development Model reinforces the importance of a territorially focused

The city of Fez is one of the first cities in Morocco to adopt a Climate Change Resilience Strategy. Why is it so important for a city like Fez to adopt such a strategy? How does it influence the preparation of the new municipal action plan?

In Morocco, as in all countries around the world, the financing needs to combat climate change far exceed public resources. The private sector is therefore called upon to play an important role, both in terms of the financing it can mobilize and the innovations it brings. What

political support is needed for the development of investments in green industries and sectors? What new skills are needed to facilitate the development of private sector activities?

How is the university preparing young people for the issues and challenges of climate change? How is the academic world equipping itself to best meet future skill demands? How can the university curriculum be adjusted to prepare for the green jobs of tomorrow? What commitment is there for students?

Do NGOs in the region have a climate change action plan? What support can NGOs and think tanks provide to combat the harmful effects of climate change?

Med2IH Consortium Meetings: a look back at flagship projects in the Euromed region



As part of the activities of the "Erasmus+, Capacity building in Higher Education (CBHE)" project held by the MED2laH program The MEDiterranean countries: Towards Internationalisation at Home, the Euromed University of Fez received a delegation composed of specialists and experts to take stock of the project's roadmap and assess the key achievements of this program. Prof. Nada Trunk, Research Professor and Advisor at EMUNI "The Euro-mediterranean University of Slovenia" opened the workshop with an overall presentation of the project.



MED2laH's One example of initiatives is "The Student Boot Camp," a competition focusing on narrating an intercultural experience in video format, which targeted 34 students from the Euromed region: Morocco, Tunisia, Egypt, Lebanon, and Jordan. The best projects won a trip to Piran, Slovenia, to meet other students from: The Euromed University of Slovenia (EMUNI). Through this bootcamp, the selected students had the opportunity to attend modules to deepen intercultural knowledge, innovation, leadership, creativity, and project management.





The MED2IaH project aims to anchor the concept of internationalization at home in universities in nine countries of the Euro-Mediterranean region: Morocco, Tunisia, Egypt, Lebanon and Jordan, Slovenia, Italy, Spain and France.

From Morocco, the project is seeing the participation of three universities from the Fez-Meknes region, namely the EuroMed University of Fez, the Moulay Ismail University of Meknes, and the Al Akhawayn University of Ifrane, which are pooling their efforts and knowledge to ensure the success of the project and jointly promote the Euro-Mediterranean cultural heritage. Ultimately, the involvement of these three Moroccan universities, with the support of the Erasmus+ Morocco Office, should make it possible to develop and design an "Internationalization at Home" model, tailored and adapted to the Moroccan context.

Signature of a partnership agreement between UEMF and Webhelp Maroc



After first week full conferences, student activities, and events, the Euromed major University of Fez (UEMF) today sealed a partnership with Webhelp, which employs more than 10,500 people in Morocco, including 4,500 in Fez, making Webhelp the leading private employer in the Fez-Meknes region.

The agreement, initialed by the President of UEMF, Pr. Mostapha Bousmina and the Managing Director of Webhelp Morocco, Mr. Redouane Mabchour, covers several aspects related to the

training and skills development of Webhelp staff who are now tackling the professions of engineering, IoT (Internet of Things), ITO (Information Technology Outsourcing), BPO (Business Process Outsourcing), Big data and digital professions, which is one of the flagship specialties of the Euromed University of Fez which has the only engineering school in the Euro-African space completely dedicated to Digital Engineering and Artificial Intelligence.

This agreement is part of the continuity of the strong relations that the UEMF undertakes with the socio-economic and industrial world and the ongoing implementation of its triptych "training, research-innovation and openness to the professions of the future".





Under this agreement, the two parties undertake to pool their efforts in order to implement a series of measures capable of boosting the professional integration of young UEMF graduates and to support Webhelp in improving the skills of its staff and also the organization of events for the benefit of young people, like the Hackathon co-organized by the two partners from September 21 to 23 for the benefit of around a hundred young people from UEMF. They are called upon to compete in ingenuity to respond to a concrete problem in the presence of experts from Webhelp and the CRI and supervised by professors from the Euromed Business School, the School of Digital Engineering and Artificial Intelligence and the Directorate of Entrepreneurship and Socio-economic Cooperation of UEMF.

Visit of EIB Vice-President Mourinho Félix to UEMF for an exchange with students on climate



On an official visit to Morocco for the first time, the Vice-President of the European Investment Bank (EIB), Mr. Ricardo Mourinho Félix, will visit the Euromed University of Fez (UEMF) on Monday, October 17.

In the presence of Professor Mostapha Bousmina, President of UEMF, Mr. Ricardo Mourinho Félix will lead a conference in front of UEMF students to highlight the importance of climate issues for young people in the run-up to the next COP 27.

This visit takes place in a "Team Europe" spirit and underlines the importance of the Morocco-EU partnership to strengthen innovation, inclusion and the pursuit of excellence in higher education.

As the upcoming 27th edition of the Conference of the Parties (COP27) approaches, scheduled to take place in Sharm El Sheikh, Egypt, from November 6 to 18, Mr. Mourinho Félix will discuss with UEMF students and lecturers the challenges and opportunities of the climate transition, as well as the role of the EIB, as a Climate Bank, in promoting sustainable models in Morocco and around the world. In the spirit of Team Europe, this visit to the UEMF ecocampus underlines the importance of the Morocco-EU partnership in strengthening skills, inclusion, and employment prospects for young people. Since 2016, the European Union and the EIB have been working alongside the Moroccan government to support various development projects, including that of UEMF with excellent teaching and research programs.

The EIB and EU support for UEMF amounts to MAD 58 million in grants and MAD 148 million in subsidies, in addition to a MAD 784 million loan from the EIB. This financing has enabled the construction and equipment of the University's eco-campus, which meets the highest international standards and now covers more than 40 hectares and is home to some 3,000 students and lecturer-researchers representing 43 nationalities. This European support has also strengthened access for the most deserving students by supporting the University's scholarship policy. By 2026, UEMF is expected to welcome more than 6,000 students from all backgrounds.



UEMF students make the voices of young Africans and Euro-Mediterraneans heard before the Parliamentary Assembly of the Union for the Mediterranean



On February 14, 2024, students from the Euromed University of Fez organized a summit under the theme "Euro-Mediterranean and Transatlantic Openness" with more than 200 participants from 30 countries. This summit addressed topics such as energy ethics, sustainable development, transportation, climate change, and African challenges.

The summit culminated in the Call for Investment in the Future, read out on February 16 at the 8th Summit of Speakers of Parliaments of the Union for the Mediterranean. This call underscores the need to strengthen cooperation between Europe and Africa through concrete projects, allocate pledged funds for climate resilience, and support initiatives such as the Nigeria-Morocco gas pipeline.

The students also welcomed Morocco's initiatives for economic integration, infrastructure, and education in Africa, while calling for a "Marshall Plan" for education and research in Africa as an investment in the future to combat poverty, terrorism, and illegal immigration.

UEMF hosts international science dissemination project on antimicrobial resistance and the fight against superbugs



The Micromonde project, developed in 17 countries, aims to bring scientific culture and biomedical research closer to students while promoting a vocation for research. The first edition concluded on the campus of the Euromed University of Fez (UEMF), with the participation of more than 100 students in pharmacy, biomedical engineering, and biotechnology. Supervised by professors from UEMF and the University of Valencia, they conducted experiments to discover new bacterial strains that produce antibiotics.

The project uses a project-based learning (PBL) method to encourage critical thinking and problem-solving. This program is part of international initiatives, such as the Small World Initiative, launched at Yale in 2012 to address the need for new antibiotics in the face of bacterial resistance. The project is supported by various consortia, with international funding and cooperation, and is being rolled out for the first time in Morocco under the UEMF-MicroMondeMaroc initiative.

Signing of the financing agreement for the "Factory Pilot School 4.0" project cofinanced by the KFW subsidiary, the Investment Facility for Employment (IFE)



On July 2, 2024, the EuroMed University of Fez (UEMF) and the Investment Facility for Employment (IFE) signed a financing agreement for the Pilot School Factory 4.0. This project, co-financed by the IFE (37.58 million DH, or 3.51 M \in) and l'UEMF (own contribution of 30%), mobilizes a total investment of 53.2 million DH (4.97 M \in) to build a training centeredie hasIndustry 4.0.

This center, which is expected to open in September 2026, will train 585 graduates and strengthen the skills of more than 1,100 professionals in its first three years of operation, creating 541 new jobs. It is part of the national digital transformation strategy and aims to support Morocco's industrial growth, particularly in the Fez-Meknes region, by offering specialized training for young graduates and professionals.

This signature marks the beginning of several similar projects financed by the IFE, in partnership with Moroccan institutional and industrial players, as part of the development of training infrastructures for the industry of tomorrow.

The UEMF is committed to mobilizing its resources to train professionals who combine tradition, innovation and sustainability while respecting the environment and social values.


A second partnership was signed with the Federation of Craft Businesses to strengthen training in glass techniques in collaboration with CERFAV in France.



Blood Donor Day: November 14, 2024








This initiative aimed to establish a collaborative roadmap between all local stakeholders, highlighting their strategic role in promoting a culture of continuous learning.

Enactus UEMF National Seminar









It is part of a transnational dynamic, bringing together a broad cohort of international critics.

Eight UEMF researchers recognized among the world's top 2% of most influential scientists



The Euromed University of Fez (UEMF) is once again in the spotlight on the international scientific scene. Eight of its research professors were ranked among the top 2% of the world's most influential scientists according to the 2025 edition of the Stanford University ranking, produced in partnership with Elsevier and Scopus.

This distinction is based on demanding bibliometric criteria (citations, h-index, co-publications, overall impact) and reflects the progress of Moroccan research, which now has 134 distinguished researchers. UEMF stands out in particular by doubling the number of its recognized researchers, going from 4 in 2024 to 8 in 2025.

This international recognition confirms the quality and impact of the work carried out at UEMF, strengthens its global visibility and constitutes a source of pride for the Moroccan scientific community.


