# SDG3 Report: Good health and well-being

## Health and Prevention

### Infirmery

The university has an infirmery which provides the following services:

- advice and awareness on health and lifestyle;
- routine care in case of illness and minor accidents;
- first aid before any possible evacuation to the approved clinic;
- referral to specialist doctors and appropriate centers



### Mental health

UEMForia <https://www.ueuromed.org/clubs/uemforia> is a student initiative that aims to raise awareness and inform students about health issues. The goal is to increase awareness of mental health issues among students.

Activities: The club organizes a series of conferences, meetings and workshops for the benefit of students and prepares them to face the stress linked to exams and promotes their integration.

### Insurance

Students and staff are covered by different types of insurance.

Additional insurance:

All university students benefit from capped supplementary insurance which covers emergency medical and hospital care provided in an approved clinic.

UEMF offers its students and staff a good quality of life within its eco-campus <https://www.ueuromed.org/leco-campus> labeled COP22 and which has just been awarded the first responsible innovation label awarded by the Agence Universitaire de la Francophonie (AUF) in 2021.

The UEMF campus has various catering facilities (student area, staff area, cafeteria) which offer students, staff and visitors balanced meals with good value for money.



## Accommodation

U Village has 1,362 single and double rooms, fully equipped and of the highest standards. All rooms have several amenities: Bathroom, kitchenette area with refrigerator and hotplate, quality bedding, desk with shelf, cupboards, individual tables, etc.

The U VILLAGE University Residence provides its residents with a comfortable, warm, healthy and secure living environment.

## Fight against diseases, pandemics and natural disasters

### Fight against COVID19

UEMF pays particular attention to the well-being and health of students and staff.

Thus, the entire university community was vaccinated against COVID19 and all precautions were applied.

UEMF has adopted a series of necessary practices to limit the risk of spreading the virus. Everyone wishing to access the campus undergoes infrared temperature checks, vehicles are disinfected at the entrance, masks are distributed, premises are disinfected in the morning and evening, access to each building is subject to shoe disinfection, and hydroalcoholic gels are placed in the busiest areas, in addition to social distancing in all offices and meeting rooms.

Upon the resumption of in-person work, a mass Covid-19 screening operation was implemented at the University for the benefit of staff, doctoral students and technical agents present on the UEMF Eco-campus. All tests were negative.

### **A wave of solidarity is being organized at the Euromed University of Fez following the earthquake that struck our Kingdom on 08/09/2023**



Following the recent earthquake that struck the Al Haouz region, our University mobilized to participate in the national solidarity movement by implementing four concrete actions:

- The mobilization of the entire university community: students, lecturer-researchers, administrative and technical staff, as well as senior management, to participate in the blood donation campaign. This initiative began on Saturday morning, 09/09/2023, extended throughout the weekend, continued to Monday, 11/09/2023, and continued throughout the week;
- The institutional and financial participation of the UEMF in the Special Fund for the Management of the Impact of the Earthquake in Morocco (a donation of 1.6 million Dirhams);
- The establishment of aid for students and staff from disaster areas.
- The contribution of 400 thousand dirhams in the form of new supplies sent by truck to the disaster areas and including beds, blankets and kitchen supplies

### **Teaching and learning in health care**

The "Health" division of the Euromed University of Fez is undergoing significant development, in perfect synergy with the reform of the national health system, driven by the High Royal Directives. Thus, the university has launched its Faculty of Medicine, which will be attached


to a new University Hospital Center (CHU), in addition to two new entities: the Faculty of Dental Medicine and the Faculty of Nursing and Health Technology.

These achievements strengthen the other existing components of this center: the Faculty of Pharmacy and the School of Biomedical and Biotechnological Engineering.

## Euromed Faculty of Medicine

The Euromed Faculty of Medicine will contribute to the development of the UEMF's Health Center and will meet the needs of physicians in the Fez-Meknes region, Morocco, and the broader MENA region, including sub-Saharan Africa. The FEM aims to be a center of innovation and excellence in medical education and research.

The FEM will develop innovative programs to better prepare future doctors to succeed in their mission in society. The Health Center will subsequently be enriched by the creation of the University Hospital Center (CHU), a hospital linked to the UEMF that will provide theoretical and practical training for future doctors and will be equipped with modern technological infrastructure to respond to the diagnoses of the main medical specialties.

As part of the diversification of its training offer and in order to contribute to the development and qualification of human resources in the field of Health, the Faculty of Nursing Sciences and Health Technology (FSITS) will welcome its first class which will include seven training courses. This training program is part of the Bachelor-Master-Doctorate (LMD) system, providing access to a range of specialties, including:

- Versatile Nurse;
- Anesthesia and intensive care nurse;

- Speech therapist;
- Psychomotor therapist;
- Dietetics-nutrition;
- Laboratory techniques;
- Radiology techniques.

The FSITS also aims to set up a training course whose educational project is to train professionals specialized in multiple disciplinary fields related to health by issuing diplomas recognized by the State allowing professional integration in the public, private and liberal sectors.

## BiomedTech Engineering School

This School aims to train high-level executives capable of supporting major projects and development projects in the countries of the Euromed basin and in sub-Saharan Africa in the health, biomedical and biotechnology sectors. To achieve this, we rely on a rich partnership network both academically (health science research centers, hospitals, etc.) and industrially.

### Training objectives

The Biotechnology Engineering program offered by EUROMED University will provide students with in-depth knowledge in biological sciences and technologies and transferable expertise and skills in a field that is experiencing rapid economic and technological expansion. This program offers a concentration in Biomolecular Engineering and Drug Development, which will benefit students pursuing careers in biological engineering, in the following industries: pharmaceutical, cosmetic, and food.

The objectives of the biotechnology engineering cycle program are as follows:

- Ability to apply critical analyses to solve problems at the interface of science, medicine and engineering;
- An ability to design and conduct experiments, as well as to analyze and interpret data;
- An understanding of the principles of modern biology and the ability to apply the principles of science, engineering and mathematics;
- In-depth training in biological sciences that will enable them to take informed and ethical approaches and to fully understand the role of the biotechnology engineer in society.
- Also, graduates will be able to communicate their work and ideas effectively, and they will be prepared to succeed in their professional and/or academic careers.
- An acquisition of an ability to use modern biological engineering techniques, skills and tools necessary for the practice of biotechnologies;
- Knowledge of contemporary issues in bioengineering and associated disciplines;
- An ability to design and produce biomolecules and biomolecular systems to meet a desired need;
- An ability to function within multidisciplinary teams;
- An ability to identify, formulate and solve engineering problems;
- An understanding of professional and ethical responsibility;
- An ability to communicate effectively;
- a recognition of the need and ability to engage in lifelong learning.

The Biomedical Engineering program is designed for students interested in applying the sciences and techniques of physics, mathematics and engineering to problems in biology. It prepares students for graduate studies in biomedical engineering and biological sciences in general, as well as for careers in biomaterials design, biomedical instrument design, medical device design (e.g. design of orthopedic prostheses, etc.). The Biomedical



Engineering cycle will provide students with theoretical and technical knowledge, expertise and transferable skills in a field that is experiencing rapid economic and technological expansion. The main objectives of this program are:

- Acquire in-depth knowledge (theoretical and practical) in biomedical engineering, and the sciences and technologies associated with it,
- Practice through educational and research experiences within the laboratories and workshops of EUROMED University of Fez, to better understand the technical and managerial problems related to the design and industrialization process in biomedical engineering.

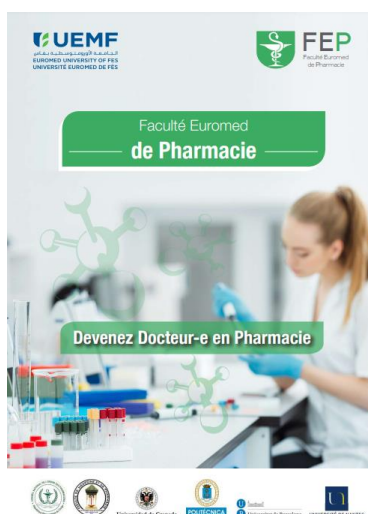
## Euromed Faculty of Pharmacy

- Green synthesis of molecules of biological and/or physicochemical interest,
- Design and synthesis of macromolecules for the vectorization of active ingredients, optical imaging and medical diagnosis,
- Extraction, isolation, characterization, semi-synthesis and valorization of natural products,
- Production of bioactive molecules by biological processes,
- Study and analysis of new cell signaling pathways
- Development of new drug administration routes,
- Development of diagnostic tests for emerging diseases,
- Identification of therapeutic targets,
- Production and purification of proteins (recombinant, natural).

## Partnerships

**Digital Health: The Covid-19 health crisis was a systematic but revealing shock, particularly in terms of the importance of digital technology in the healthcare sector, and on several levels.**

The "Health and Digital" symposium, organized by the National School of Arts and Crafts of the Mohammed V University of Rabat, is to share thoughts on the impact of digitalization on the health system in general and in Morocco in particular, and also, to identify avenues for future research in the field of complementarity between digitalization & health.

This academic and industrial event saw the signing of partnership agreements with the Digital Development Agency, the Pasteur Institute, the Euromed University of Fez, the Mohammed VI University of Health Sciences and Huawei Morocco. Authorities from the Ministry of National Education, Vocational Training, Higher Education and Scientific Research and the Ministry of Health were also present.

### UEMF-CHU (University Hospital Center) Agreement

Research and innovation is a very important aspect of UEMF. Today, the University is expanding its portfolio of strategic partners in this regard by signing an agreement between Professor Mostapha Bousmina, President of UEMF, and Professor Mohamed Nouredine Al Amin, Director General of the Hassan II Hospital Center in Fez, to advance knowledge and science.

The mission of this framework agreement is to provide support to UEMF research units, particularly in the biomedical and biotechnological fields, through three major areas:

- 1- Ensure common, high-quality training in research through research.
- 2- Supervise the research projects of research professors and doctoral students.
- 3- Organize occasional scientific and intellectual events in the biomedical field.

### Women and Science Chair

Following the signing of an agreement between the UEMF and the Islamic World Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (ICESCO) on May 17 for the establishment of a "Women in Science" chair in the field of Artificial Intelligence, the two parties celebrated the official launch of this project today. This chair is headed by Professor Maha Gmira, a professornante at UEMF, holder of a doctorate from the École Polytechnique de Montréal, in one of the centersof global excellence on AI, data science for real-time decision making IVADO, CIRRELT, GERAD, etc. and MILA led by Prof. Yoshua Bengio. With the aim of strengthening the contribution of women in digital technology and attracting female doctoral students to carry out research projects in this field, the chair aims to be a starting point for launching high value-added projects on an African-Euro-Mediterranean scale. The first training sessions were aimed at female doctors to help them better use AI tools in their analysis and diagnostic work.

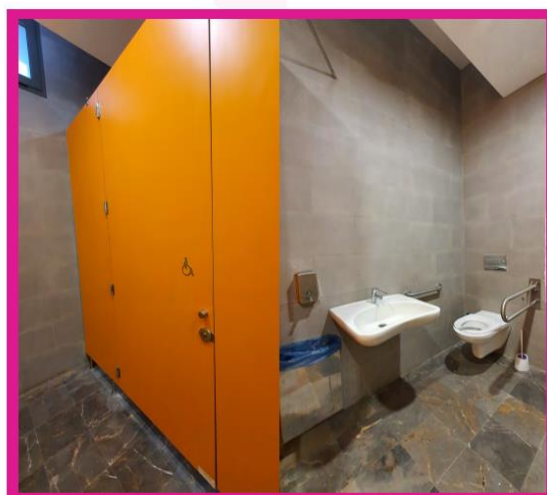

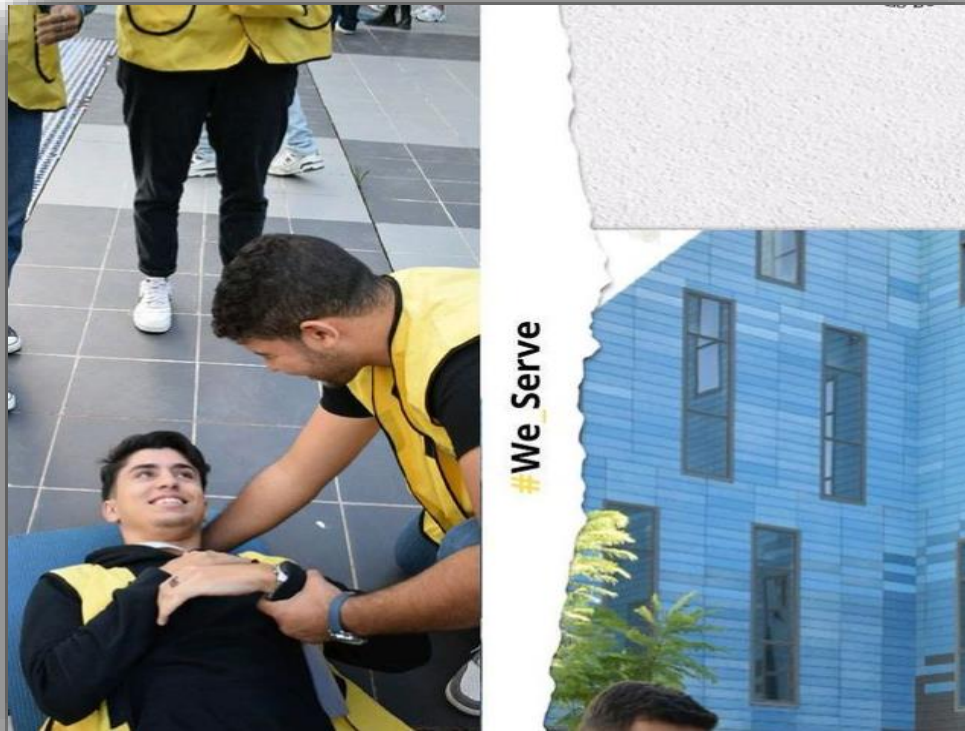

### Signing of an agreement between the Euromed University of Fez and the Moroccan Association of Occupational Health

Doctoral Thesis Defense in "Additive Manufacturing and Materials Science" by Mr. Patrick MUNYENSANGA



This thesis explores the widespread use of metallic implants in medical and orthopedic surgery, which is faced with limitations such as implant degradation and long-term bonding incompatibilities. To address these limitations, the thesis proposes to improve the interfacial surface of implants, promote faster bone regeneration and better bioactivity, as well as improve biocorrosion resistance. A lightweight and porous metallic implant coated with bioactive glass was developed to stimulate osteogenic cell proliferation, promote bone ingrowth, and overcome structural bonding incompatibilities. The bioactive glass demonstrates the ability to impregnate antibacterial and therapeutic agents essential for osseointegration with the host organism. The results confirmed the formation of a bone-like layer on the implant surface, as well as improved biocorrosion resistance. This surface modification approach shows significant potential for improving the durability of orthopedic implants.

## UEMF hosts international science dissemination project on antimicrobial resistance and the fight against superbugs



The Micromonde project, developed in 17 countries, aims to bring scientific culture and biomedical research closer to students while promoting a vocation for research. The first edition concluded on the campus of the Euromed University of Fez (UEMF), with the participation of more than 100 students in pharmacy, biomedical engineering, and biotechnology. Supervised by professors from UEMF and the University of Valencia, they conducted experiments to discover new bacterial strains that produce antibiotics.

The project uses a project-based learning (PBL) method to encourage critical thinking and problem-solving. This program is part of international initiatives, such as the Small World Initiative, launched at Yale in 2012 to address the need for new antibiotics in the face of bacterial resistance. The project is supported by various consortia, with international funding and cooperation, and is being rolled out for the first time in Morocco under the UEMF-MicroMondeMaroc initiative.

The Euromed University of Fez (UEMF) was honored to host the "World Thinkers Invited to ICESCO" conference, bringing together international experts in art therapy and music therapy. This event, organized in partnership with the Islamic World Educational, Scientific, and Cultural Organization (ICESCO), addressed key issues surrounding art therapy, cultural inclusion, and the rights of people with disabilities.

Speakers included renowned figures such as Professor Emeritus Edith Lecourt, a pioneer in music therapy and founder of university art therapy programs, and André Fertier, a fervent defender of cultural rights. The program included lively lectures and discussions, focusing on art therapy training methods, music therapy as a cultural therapy, and the importance of ensuring access to artistic culture for all.

The event, which took place at the UEMF premises before continuing in Rabat, demonstrates the Euromed University of Fez's commitment to promoting inclusive culture and well-being through the arts.

COVID-19, caused by SARS-CoV-2, has caused an unprecedented global health crisis, highlighting the urgency of developing new antiviral therapies. Among the promising therapeutic targets, the main viral protease (Mpro) plays a crucial role in the maturation of viral polyproteins required for virus replication. Inhibiting this enzyme represents a key strategy to block the viral life cycle.

This thesis focuses on the development of new bioactive molecules targeting the main enzymes of SARS-CoV-2, notably Mpro and PLpro, in order to contribute to the fight against COVID-19. This work combines organic chemistry, molecular modeling, and ADMET evaluation approaches to design and synthesize ethacrynic acid-based derivatives of indole as well as other molecules derived from modified amino acids.

The studied compounds were characterized using spectroscopic techniques (NMR, IR, UV, HRMS) and tested for their interaction with target enzymes. The results show promising properties, including favorable binding energies and good reactivity with key residues, suggesting inhibitory potential. In vivo validation was also considered to confirm the efficacy and safety of the compounds.

This research paves the way for the design of new antivirals that can be developed to treat viral infections, while enriching knowledge on medicinal chemistry applied to emerging viruses.

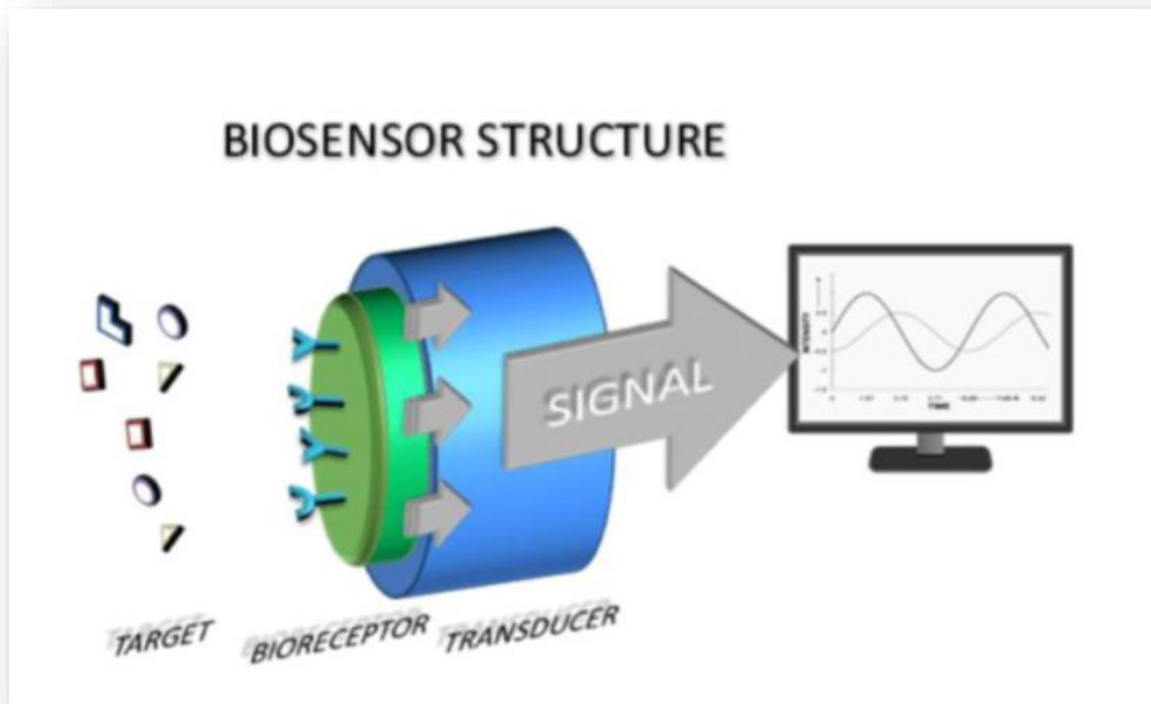

“Design, Modeling and Realization of Optofluidic Sensors Based on Surface Plasmon Resonance for Precision Sensing.”

This thesis focuses on the development of high-performance optofluidic biosensors based on the surface plasmon resonance (SPR) phenomenon. A novel golden ratio approach was proposed to optimize the geometric properties of a gold-silver bimetallic configuration, achieving rapid optimization with enhanced sensitivity and resolution.

Additionally, a dual-mode plasmonic configuration combining guided modes in a dielectric waveguide and plasmonic modes on a gold film was studied. This configuration generates a detection mode (PIT) with high performance and a reference mode (TM1) to improve measurement reliability by minimizing false positives.

Finally, a new approach for microfluidic system manufacturing using stereolithography additive manufacturing was developed, integrating real-time temperature control. This method improved the mechanical and structural properties of microfluidic chips, making them highly suitable for biosensing applications, as confirmed by microscopic analyzes and mechanical tests.

### School health caravan in Aouzay

## Medical-Dental Caravan in Dar Abkhtie

## Medical-Dental Caravan in Agoudim



To mark the holy month of Ramadan, the Elite Club of the Euromed University of Fez, in partnership with the Hand in Hand Club of Al Akhawayn University, organized a two-day medical-dental caravan to the isolated village of Agoudim, in the Middle Atlas. This humanitarian mission was distinguished by the diversity of medical specialties involved, the quality of the welcome given to patients, and its deep roots in the local community.

Over the course of a weekend, general practitioners and specialists (in ophthalmology, gynecology, dermatology, and ENT) provided free consultations to residents, mostly women, children, and the elderly. A comprehensive dental component was also provided, with basic care, extractions, scaling, and awareness-raising activities on oral hygiene.

One of the highlights of the mission was the distribution of hygiene kits (toothbrushes, toothpaste) and medicines, extending the positive impact of the intervention beyond the caravan.

Mohamed Amine Benzaouia, a doctoral student in the NANOMat (Nanomaterials) team at Euromed University of Fez, is conducting innovative research on the development of new antibacterial and antiviral materials. This project, supported by the Hassan II Academy of Science and Technology, is part of a national strategy to strengthen scientific capacity in the face of pandemics, particularly COVID-19.

As part of his work, Mr. Benzaouia participated in the international conference MEDPore25 (Mediterranean Conference on Porous Materials), recently held in Marrakech. He presented a scientific poster entitled: "Nitrogen-containing mesoporous organosilicas as antibacterial materials." This presentation was awarded the Best Poster Award, recognizing scientific excellence, clarity of the subject, and visual quality of the poster.

Currently pursuing a thesis at the NANOMat laboratory, this distinction highlights the dynamism of research conducted at UEMF in the field of nanomaterials applied to health. It also illustrates the university's growing impact on the international scientific scene.

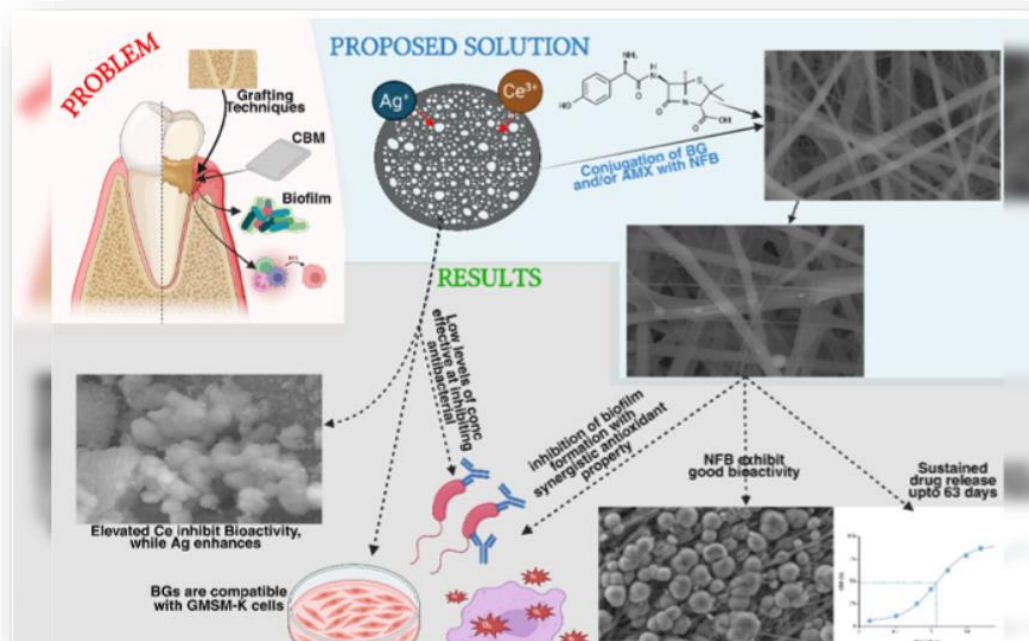
## UEMF seals strategic partnerships with seven national sports federations

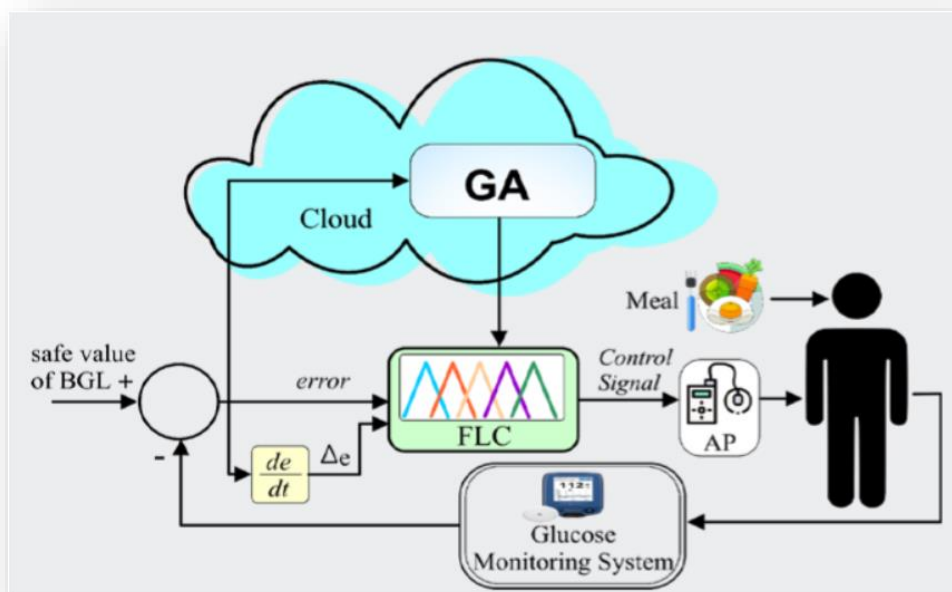

The National School Volleyball Championship ended on April 12, 2025 at the UEMF Sports Center, after four days of intense competition.

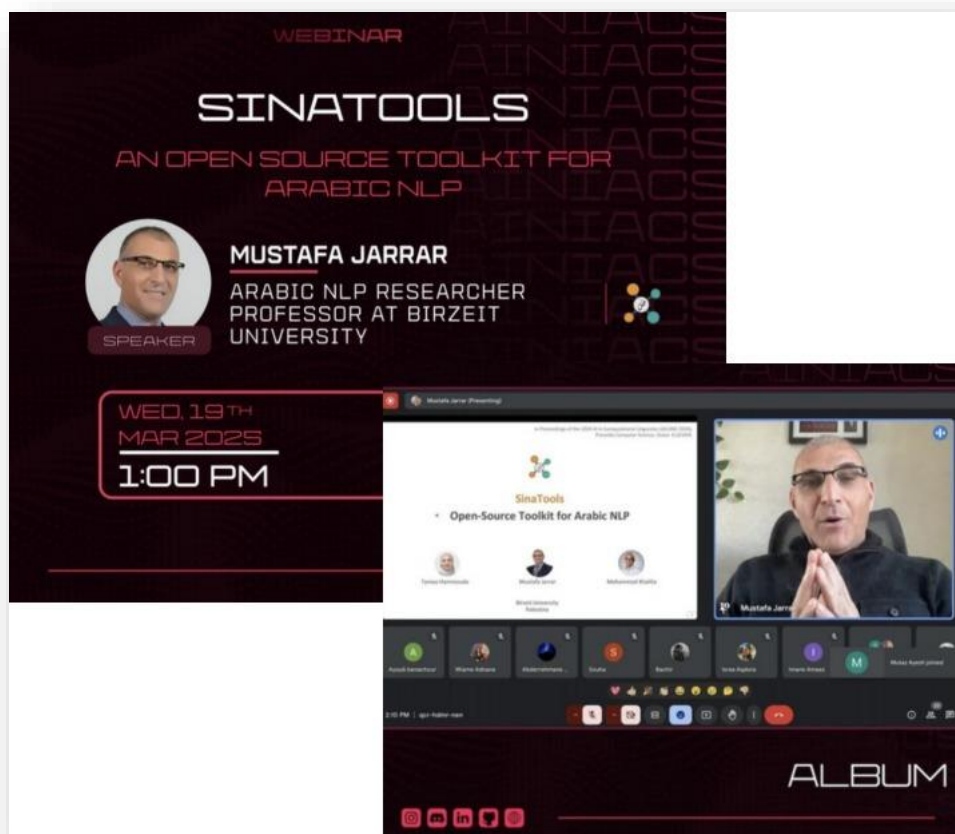
The event was marked by a strong sportsmanship spirit as well as environmental awareness actions.

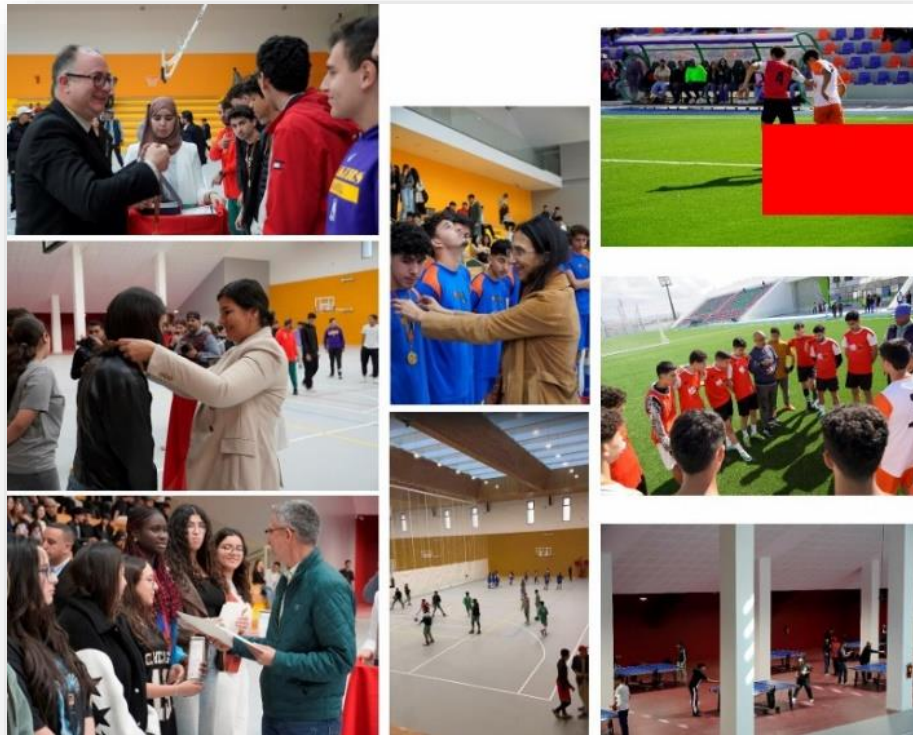


The Rotaract Club, in partnership with the National Center for the Disabled in Fez, organized an art workshop for autistic children.

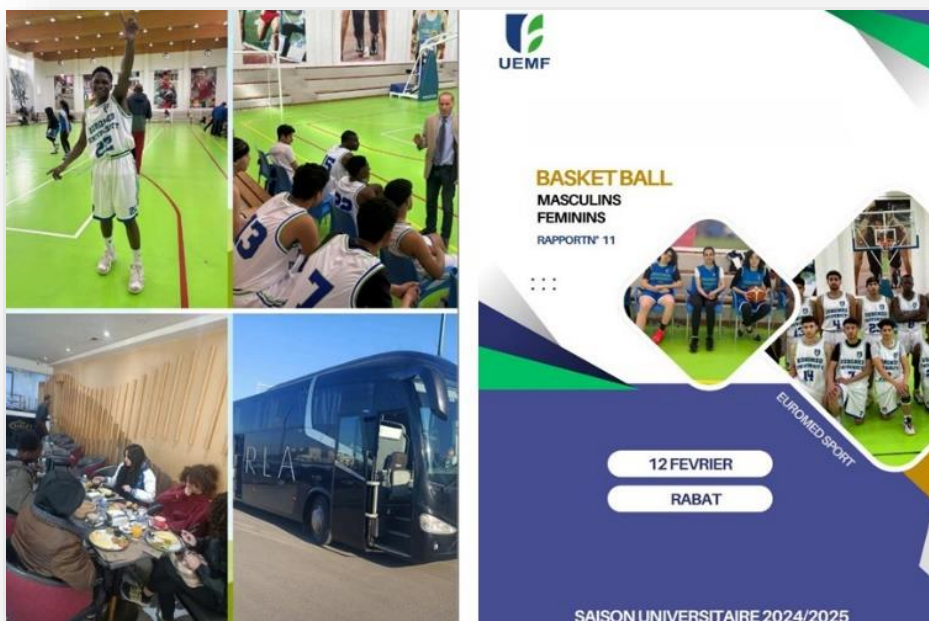
### Sports activity: Friendly volleyball match

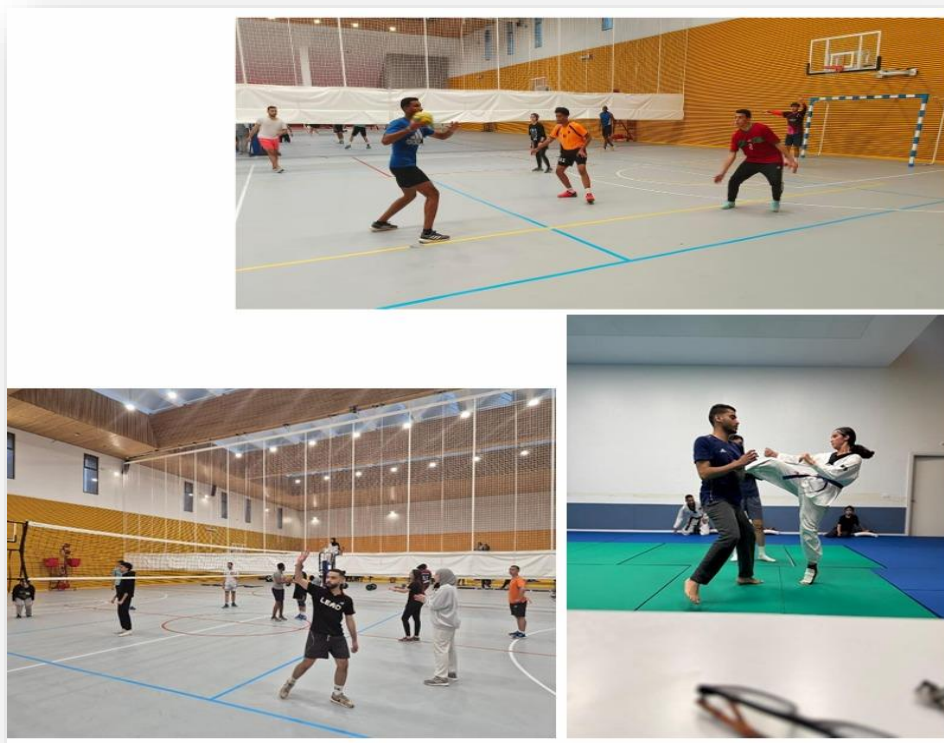
## UEMF participation in the University Basketball Championship

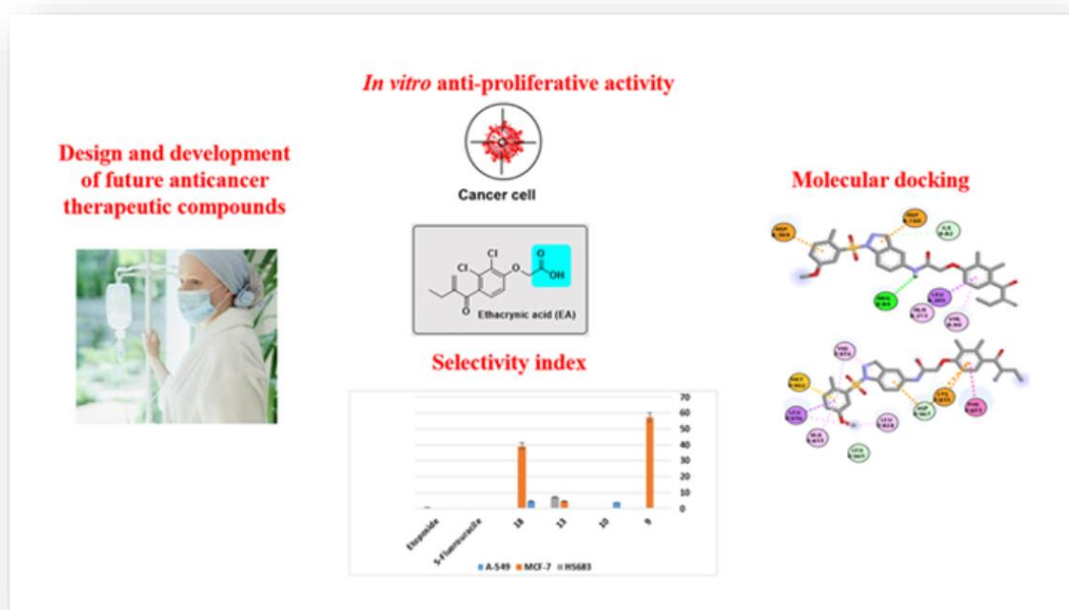
## Between knowledge and duty: our future health professionals in action

This thesis project focuses on the design and synthesis of novel anticancer molecules derived from ethacrynic acid and indazole, combined with sulfonamides. Through advanced structural modifications, including coupling of heterocyclic groups via the Sonogashira reaction, several compounds have shown promising antiproliferative activity in vitro. A new class of ligands has also been developed to form metal complexes, including one with ruthenium, paving the way for future developments in cancer chemotherapy.

## Dental research: a look back at the IADR 2025 congress in Barcelona

A member of the IADR, Professor El Mabrouk is one of the few Moroccan representatives of this international scientific organization, thus strengthening the UEMF's visibility in global research networks. His participation reflects the university's commitment to cutting-edge research and innovation.
