Fight against COVID19

UEMF pays particular attention to the well-being and health of students and staff.

Thus the entire university community was vaccinated against COVID19 and all precautions were applied.

The UEMF has adopted a series of necessary practices to limit the risk of spreading the virus. Anyone wanting to access the campus has their temperature taken by infrared, vehicles are disinfected upon entry, masks are distributed, places are disinfected in the morning and evening, access to each building is subject to the shoe disinfection and hydro-alcoholic gels are placed in the most frequented areas, in addition to social distancing in all offices and meeting rooms.

When face-to-face work resumed, a massive Covid-19 screening operation was set up at the University for the benefit of staff, doctoral students and technical agents present on the UEMF Eco-campus. All tests were negative

Following the recent earthquake which struck the Al Haouz region, our University mobilized to participate in the surge of national solidarity by implementing four concrete actions:

The mobilization of the entire university community: students, teacher-researchers, administrative and technical staff, as well as senior management, to participate in the blood donation campaign. This initiative began on Saturday morning, 09/09/2023, extended throughout the weekend, continued until Monday,

09/11/2023, and continued throughout the week;

- The institutional and financial participation of the UEMF in the Special Fund for Managing the Impact of the Earthquake in Morocco (a donation of 1.6 million Dirhams);
- The provision of aid for students and staff from disaster areas.
- The contribution of 400 thousand dirhams in the form of new supplies sent by truck to the disaster areas and including beds, blankets and kitchen supplies


backed by a new University Hospital Center (CHU), in addition to two new entities: the Faculty of Dentistry and the Faculty of Nursing and Health Technology.

These achievements reinforce the other already existing components of this center: the faculty of pharmacy and the School of biomedical and biotechnology engineering.

Euromed Faculty of Medicine

The Euromed Faculty of Medicine will contribute to the development of the UEMF Health Center, and will respond to the needs for doctors in the Fez-Meknes region, Morocco and the MENA region extended to sub-Saharan Africa. The FEM aims to be a place of innovation and excellence in medical teaching and research.

The FEM will develop innovative programs to better prepare future doctors to succeed in their mission in society. The Health center will subsequently be enriched by the creation of the University Hospital Center (CHU), a hospital linked to the UEMF which will allow the theoretical and practical training of future doctors and which will be equipped with modern technological infrastructures to respond to the diagnoses of main medical specialties.

Training aims

The Biotechnology Engineering program, offered by EUROMED University will provide students with in-depth knowledge in biological sciences and technologies and transferable expertise and skills in a rapidly expanding field; economic and technological. This program offers a concentration in Biomolecular Engineering and Drug Development which will benefit students pursuing a career in biological engineering, or in the following industries: pharmaceutical, cosmetics, and food processing.

The objectives of the biotechnology engineering cycle program are as follows:

- Ability to apply critical analyzes to solve problems at the interface of science, medicine and engineering;
- An ability to design and conduct experiments, as well as analyze and interpret data;
- An understanding of the principles of modern biology and the ability to apply the principles of science, engineering and mathematics;
- In-depth training in biological sciences which will allow them to take informed and ethical steps and to fully understand the role of the biotechnology engineer in society.
- Also, graduates will be able to effectively communicate their work and ideas, and they
 will be prepared to succeed in their professional and/or academic careers.
- An acquisition of an ability to use modern biological engineering techniques, skills and tools necessary for the practice of biotechnology;
- Knowledge of contemporary issues in bioengineering and associated disciplines;
- An ability to design and produce biomolecules and biomolecular systems to meet a desired need;
- An ability to function within multidisciplinary teams;
- An ability to identify, formulate and solve engineering problems;
- An understanding of professional and ethical responsibility;
- An ability to communicate effectively;
- a recognition of the need and ability to engage in lifelong learning.

The Biomedical Engineering program is designed for students interested in applying the sciences and techniques of physics, mathematics, and engineering to problems in biology. It prepares students for graduate studies in biomedical engineering and biological sciences in general, as well as for careers in biomaterial design, biomedical instrument design, medical device design (e.g. orthopedic prosthetic design, etc.)) The biomedical engineering cycle will provide students with theoretical and technical





knowledge, expertise and transferable skills in a rapidly expanding field; economic and technological. The main objectives of this sector are:

- Acquire in-depth knowledge (theoretical and practical) in biomedical engineering, and the sciences and technologies associated with it,
- Practice through educational and research experiences within the laboratories and workshops of EUROMED University of Fez, to better understand the technical and managerial problems linked to the design and industrialization process in biomedical engineering.

- Design and manufacturing by 3D printing of several thousand visors (sterilizable) which were distributed to hospitals, the Wilaya, town halls and the police headquarters and public administrations
- Design and manufacturing by 3D printing of elbows allowing the use of a respirator for several patients
- Design and manufacturing by 3D printing of antibacterial and antiviral masks, washable, sterilizable and reusable with disposable filters.
- Design and manufacturing by 3D printing of adapters for Decathlon masks
- Design and manufacturing by 3D printing of washable, sterilizable and reusable masks with disposable filters for the deaf and mute (lip reading)
- Design and manufacture of door opening devices using the arm.
- Development, design and manufacturing by 3D printing of a respiratory valve to facilitate the oxygenation of patients without requiring a mechanical respirator. The device has been the subject of a patent application and is already in use
- Design and manufacturing of air flow sensors by 3D printing.

- 3- Organize occasional scientific and intellectual events in the biomedical field.


Women and Sciences Chair


After the signing of an agreement between the UEMF and the Islamic World Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (ICESCO) on May 17 for the establishment of a "Women in Sciences" chair, in the field of Artificial Intelligence, both parties today celebrated the official launch of this project. This chair is directed by Pr. Maha Gmira, professornante at the UEMF, holder of a doctorate from the École Polytechnique de Montréal, in one of the centersof excellence on AI, data science for real-time decision-making IVADO, CIRRELT, GERAD, etc. and MILA led by Prof. Yoshua Bengio. With the objective of strengthening the contribution of women in digital technology and attracting doctoral students to carry out research projects in this area, the chair aims to be a starting point for the launch of projects with high added value at the African-Euro-Mediterranean scale. The first training courses concerned female doctors in order to help them better use AI tools in their analysis and diagnosis work.
